INTRODUCTION

Mayor Brucker has requested that the City Council consider joining an *amicus* brief to the California Supreme Court filed by the City of West Hollywood on behalf of itself and several other cities supporting the petitions challenging Proposition 8.

DISCUSSION

In November, the voters of California approved Proposition 8, which changed the State Constitution to restrict the definition of marriage to opposite-sex couples and eliminated same-sex couples' right to marry. Proponents of same-sex marriage in the state have filed for legal relief from the Supreme Court of California challenging the enforceability of Proposition 8.

Interested parties have submitted over three dozen *amicus* briefs in an effort to overturn the ban. An *amicus* brief has been filed by the City of West Hollywood on behalf of itself and several other cities. Mayor Brucker requests that the City of Beverly Hills join that brief.

Meeting Date: February 3, 2009

In order to join the amicus brief, the City would need to obtain the permission of the California Supreme Court as the deadline for filing the brief has passed.

This would require the filing of a short petition to the California Supreme Court seeking relief from the deadline and also requesting that the City be allowed to join the *amicus* brief filed by the City of West Hollywood.
