


In response to your letter of May 26, 2009, I would like to state my strong interest in reappointment as a Beverly Hills Health and Safety Commissioner once my current term expires in November.


My term on the Health and Safety Commission is expiring on November 19, 2009. I would like to be considered for reappointment to a second term.

The Commission was able to define the mission and priorities based on the goals established by the City Council, and we were also able to begin implementation of community-based health and safety programs.


