RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt the resolution amending the fees and charges for Fiscal Year 2010/2011.

INTRODUCTION

The City charges a range of permit fees, charges, rental and use fees, taxes and other fees or payments, which are listed in a comprehensive schedule called "Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges" (hereinafter "Schedule of Fees & Charges" or "Schedule"). The Schedule contains the following sections:

- Section 1 – Ambulance & Alarm Fees
- Section 2 – Appeals & Hearings
- Section 3 – Business Permits
- Section 4 – Copies, Reports, etc.
- Section 5 – Facilities Use Fees
- Section 6 – Inspections, Permits & Reviews

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- Section 7 – Library Services
- Section 8 – Parking Citations
- Section 9 – Parking Rates
- Section 10 – Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses
- Section 11 – Special Events & Filming
- Section 12 – Taxes
- Section 13 – Utility Rates & Fees

Maintaining a comprehensive book with all the various fees, charges and taxes ensures that the City provides the public with one document that contains all city fees rather than providing the information in several documents or in piecemeal form. In addition, the Schedule is available on the City's website. Although the City reviews the Schedule yearly, there are times when revisions are made to certain fees during the year. When that occurs, the comprehensive book is updated.

With the passage of Proposition 4 that became Article XIII B of the State Constitution, fee services cannot exceed the "costs reasonable borne" by the City in delivery of such services. In compliance with this State law, the City periodically performs a full cost study to confirm current costs of services and to recommend cost recovery levels for these fee-based programs, the last cost study was performed in 2007 by the Revenue & Cost Specialists, LLC consulting group.

In accordance with Section 3-1.1001 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code ("Municipal Code") and Ordinance No. 79-0-1749, City fees and charges are adjusted annually, based upon the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the preceding twelve months. Taxes contained in Section 12 are also adjusted each year pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Code. Utility Rates set forth in Section 13 are adopted by separate ordinance, as are parking meter rates set forth in Section 9. Parking citations are periodically adjusted by resolution as are parking rates for the City's parking structures.

Adjustments to the fees and charges contained in the Schedule are set by City Council resolution. At this time, the only sections under consideration by the City Council are Sections 1 through 7, certain parking fees relating to various parking permits and similar charges in Section 9, Sections 10 and 11 and fees related to the provision of utilities and similar charges in Section 13. Utility rates contained in Section 13 will be reviewed and acted upon separately by the City Council at its June 3, 2010 City Council meeting. Certain portions of Section 9 relating to parking rates in the City's facilities were recently reviewed by the City Council.

Exhibit A to the Resolution contains the fees and rates for Fiscal Year 2010/2011, which has been adjusted to reflect increases based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 0.9%. In some cases, the fees and/or charges are adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more equitable distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI. Attachment 2 contains a redlined Schedule that shows the revisions. Fees that increased above the CPI are shown in green. Fees that have been reduced are shown in red. New fees are shown in blue. Strikeouts indicate deletion of text that is no longer relevant and/or clean up.

Except as otherwise indicated, all non-development fees are scheduled to become effective July 1, 2010. Fees for development applications, per State law, become effective 60 days after adoption of the adjusted fee schedule, on July 19, 2010.

DISCUSSION

A. FEES ADJUSTED BY THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)

The fees and charges set forth in Exhibit “A” to the Resolution have been increased by 0.9%, except as noted below. This percentage increase represents the difference between the CPI of November 2008 and November 2009. The fees that were not adjusted in line with the CPI are further discussed below.

For ease of collection, fees have been rounded to the nearest dime (\$0.10), with the exception of the following:

- 1) Fees charged by Community Services, which were rounded upward to the nearest dollar in response to the staff’s and the public’s request that the City’s fees be rounded off when and where it is possible.
- 2) Fees that are less than \$1.00.

B. FEES INCREASED IN THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR (2009/2010)

The following fees were increased during this fiscal year and are included here for reference.

Athletic Fields and Facilities

New fees for use of athletic fields reserved by organized sports leagues, such as youth sport organizations, the primary users of the fields and facilities, were previously approved by the City Council. The new fees, shown under Section 10 (Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses), were established to offset the increasing costs associated with the upkeep and maintenance of City athletic fields and facilities. A list of the fees is provided below.

Staff estimates that the cost recovery realized for Fiscal Year 2010/11 from the current fee structure, as approved by the City Council in late 2009, will be approximately \$125,000. The City Council Liaison Committee (Vice Mayor Brucker and Councilmember Brien) will be making a report to the full City Council on these fees with an alternative recommendation derived from meetings with youth athletic groups. (See Attachment 1, Youth Sports Fees By Organization 2010.) Staff estimates that the new fee structure proposal, if approved, would reduce the City’s

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cost recovery efforts by approximately \$29,075, to \$95,925 for Fiscal Year 2010/11. This \$29,075 reduction would necessitate additional General Fund cuts or other alternatives to recapture the reduction.

Brush Clearance Inspection Fees

The Fire Department's Vegetation Management Program, more commonly referred to as Brush Clearance Inspection fees, shown under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) were initiated in the Fiscal Year 2009/10 budget cycle as a means of achieving full cost recovery of a service provided by the Fire Department on properties located in a high fire hazard zone. Recently, the Fire Department has reviewed this fee in light of concerns raised by homeowners impacted by the fee. As a result, the Fire Department has proposed a revision to the fee that would reduce the initial inspection fee from a flat \$383.28 per property to the following schedule:

If approved, this new fee schedule would recover about \$208,600, which is approximately \$374,000 less than the fee imposed last year. The amount (\$208,600) from this proposed change has already been incorporated into the Proposed Fiscal Year 2010/11 budget and its adoption would not impact the budget.

Correctable Citation Sign-off Fee

The Police Department adopted a new program to allow its officers to inspect vehicles that have been cited for violations that can be corrected (i.e. fix-it tickets). In such cases, the officer certifies that the correction has been made. To allow the Department to recover its costs, a new fee of \$15 was adopted and is contained in Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews).

Parking Rates

As previously mentioned, Parking Rates related to parking facilities were recently adjusted by City Council action, and are not being reviewed or adjusted at this time.

Vehicle Impound Storage Program

Fees related to the Vehicle Impound Storage Program (Daily Storage Fee, Lien Sale Processing Fees, and Vehicle Auction Purchase Deposit) were adopted in October 2009, and are listed below for reference. These fees appear under Section 4 (Copies, Reports, Etc.) of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges, as follows:

Staff is recommending revisions to several of the fees for Fiscal Year 2010/11 as follows:

- Basic and Investigative Impound Release Fees: These fees have been reduced to reflect the revised amount of staff time involved in the processing of impounded vehicles.
- Daily Storage Fee: The daily storage fee for impounded vehicles and motorcycles has been increased by 5%, in an effort to achieve full cost recovery by increasing the daily storage fee for the Vehicle Impound Storage program gradually over a five-year period.
- Auction Vehicles: The fee for a Vehicle Auction Purchase Deposit has been increased by 4.4%, to ensure that the City does not incur a loss for vehicles sold at lien sale auction.

C. FEES INCREASED ABOVE CPI

As stated above, some fees are adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more equitable distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI. With the exception of rounding to the nearest dime, the fees that are being increased above the CPI are shown on the Schedule in green and are outlined below.

Building & Safety Fees

The following Building & Safety fees, listed under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) are recommended for increase above the CPI. In the past, the City's General Fund has been subsidizing these services, and these proposed increases are to achieve full cost recovery of staff time involved in conducting review of applications or processing of permits.

- Extension of Plan Review / Expiration Dates:
 - The proposed increase is from \$41.10 to \$51.80, or 26%. The fee increase is to recover the fully burdened cost of half hour of administrative work by a Development Service Technician.
- Table No. 3A–Building Permit Fees - Reinspection fee due to incomplete work: This fee is proposed for increase from \$81.00 to \$155.80, or 92.3%. This fee will be increased to reflect the fully burdened hourly rate of a Senior Building Inspector. Reinspection fees are charged to projects with multiple inspections where an inspector goes out to the site and finds that the work is incomplete and the contractor requested the inspection prematurely. Staff conducts 30 to 50 of these types of inspections annually. For ease of reference, the reinspection fee is also listed separately for plumbing, electrical, and mechanical building permits.

- Other Plan Review and Inspection Fees:
 - Plan Review/Planning Research for which no formal application has been made: The proposed increase is from \$86.10 to \$188.30, or 118.70%. This fee was adjusted to reflect the fully burdened hourly cost (which includes salary, benefits, maintenance and operations, and overhead) spent by a plan reviewer or a planner at the counter on a preliminary design review.
 - Additional Plan Review (due to changes, additions, or revisions): The proposed increase is from \$86.10 to \$188.30, or 118.70%. This fee was adjusted to recover the fully burdened hourly cost (which includes salary, benefits, maintenance and operations, and overhead) spent by a plan reviewer on plan revisions as requested by the applicant.
- Document Maintenance Fee (B&S and Planning - 10% of permit/application fee): This fee was established several years ago to recover the staff costs associated with document management and storage of plans and digital conversion during plan review and construction. The current fee is 10% of the permit fees, with a minimum amount of \$25.80, being recommended for a CPI increase to \$26 and maximum or cap of \$388.40. For large projects, this \$388.40 cap limits the department's cost-recovery efforts and therefore a cap increase to \$1,000, or 157.5%, is requested to accommodate these large projects and to ensure full cost recovery to the City.

Engineering Fees

The following Engineering fees, listed under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) are recommended for increase above the CPI.

- Subdivision Map Act Fees - Subdivision Map Act fees are recommended to be increased to achieve full cost recovery of the staff time involved in conducting review of applications or processing of permits. In Fiscal Year 2009/10, the fee of \$2,100 covered only the processing of subdivision related applications by the City's consultant, RKA and omitted costs for city staff to process the application for completeness review, coordination with the Planning Division and the applicant/engineer, preparation of staff report and resolution approving final map, and transmittal of final documents to the Los Angeles County Recorder, including recordation fees. The approximate time for all of these tasks is approximately eight hours of a civil engineer's time of \$137, or approximately \$1,096. Thus, staff is recommending the following changes to the Subdivision Map Act fees:
 - Final parcel map (per map) (first through third submittal): increase fee from \$2,100 to \$3,100, resulting in a 47.6% increase.
 - Final tract map (per map) (first through third submittal): increase fee from \$2,100 to \$3,100, resulting in a 47.6% increase.

- Lot line adjustment (per application): increase fee from \$1,600 to \$2,600, resulting in a 62.5% increase.
- Inspection Fees
The following inspection fees are recommended for increase to achieve full cost recovery of the staff time involved in conducting review of applications or processing of permits:
 - Driveway Approach Permit - The cost of each additional approach after the first, plus the cost for each new and widened location, are proposed to increase from \$110 to \$117, or 6.4%.
 - Sidewalk Replacement Street Use Permit - The cost, above the permit fee, per square foot is proposed to increase from \$0.45 to \$0.48, or 6.7%.
 - Curb and Gutter Permit - The cost, above the permit fee, per linear foot is proposed to increase from \$4.50 to \$4.80, or 6.7%, and the cost for Commercial/Large Multi-Family units, per linear foot, is proposed to increase from \$150 to \$159, or 6.0%.
 - Sewer Lateral Installation Permit - The cost, above the permit fee, per square foot of sewer lateral installation is proposed to increase from \$1.40 to \$1.40, or 6.4%, and the cost for underground service alert is proposed to increase from \$26.00 to \$27.60, or 6.2%.
 - Construction Barricade/Fence Structure Use Permit - The cost, above the permit fee, per linear foot per month of construction barricade/fence structure is proposed to increase from \$1.10 to \$1.17, or 6.4%.
 - Utility Permit - The cost, above the permit fee, per square foot of excavation is proposed to increase from \$1.40 to \$1.49, or 6.4%, and the cost for underground service alert is proposed to increase from \$26.00 to \$27.60, or 6.2%.
- Hauling / Street Use Fees
The various fees listed under Hauling / Street Use Fees are proposed for increase above the CPI fee to achieve full cost recovery of the staff time involved in conducting review of applications or processing of permits.
 - Housing Move Permit is proposed to increase from \$1,000 to \$1,063, or 6.3%.
 - Heavy Haul Permit per cubic yard for roadway degradation is proposed to increase from \$0.60 to \$0.64, or 6.7%.
 - Dumpster Permit street use rental fee is proposed to increase from \$100 to \$106.30, or 6.3%.

- Loading/Unloading Street Use Permit, per No Parking sign, is proposed for increase from \$4.90 to \$5.20, or 6.1%, plus the street use rental fee is proposed to increase from \$100 to \$106.30, or 6.3%.
- Motor Coach Load/Unload Street Use Permit, per No Parking sign, is proposed for increase from \$4.90 to \$5.20, or 6.1%, plus the street use rental fee is proposed to increase from \$100 to \$106.30
- Traffic / Parking / Street Lights Fees
The following fees listed under Traffic / Parking / Street Lights are proposed for increase above the CPI fee to achieve full cost recovery of the staff time involved in conducting review of applications or processing of permits.
 - Parking Meter Head Remove/Install Permit – per head plus lost parking meter revenue is proposed to increase from \$165 to \$175, or 6.1%.
 - Traffic/Parking Sign & Post Removal Permit – per sign is proposed to increase from \$165 to \$175, or 6.1%.
- Special Events Fees
The Special Events fees – per No Parking signs plus lost parking revenue, is proposed to increase from \$4.90 to \$5.20, or 6.1%, plus the fee that includes a street use rental is proposed to increase from \$50 to \$53, or 6.0%.
- Oil, Gas & Minerals Drilling and Extension of Time Permits
The fee for Drilling Permit – Variable directional or relocation is proposed to increase from \$8,300 to \$8,822, or 6.3%.

Film/Event Permits

The fees below, related to Film/Events, are contained in Section 11 (Special Events & Filming) and are recommended for increases as follows:

- Special Events – Personnel Charges. Staff recommends that the fee for providing a Traffic Control Officer at special events be increased from \$40 per hour, with a four-hour minimum, to \$42 per hour, with a four-hour minimum. This rate continues to be well below the fully-loaded rate of approximately \$89 per hour (based on the cost study performed in 2007 by the Revenue & Cost Specialists, LLC, plus salary and CPI increases in subsequent years), yet staff recommends keeping the increase to a minimal amount in order to continue to attract events to the city.
- Motion Picture/Video Taping/Filming on Rodeo Drive – It is recommended that filming on Rodeo Drive be addressed as a unique location and the fees keep pace with “going rates” for other unique locations in the Los Angeles area. An increase from \$1,180 to

\$1,263, which represents a 7.0% increase instead of the CPI of 0.9%, is recommended.

- Still Photography on Rodeo Drive is also recommended for an increase above CPI, from \$161 to \$172, or a 6.8% increase.
- K-Rails: staff recommends a 4.6% increase, from \$26, each, to \$27.20, each, to the K Rails fees listed under Additional Film Fees – Still Photography and Filming, in order to make this fee consistent with the same fee for K Rails listed under Special Event Permits.

Groundwater Replenishment Fee

The Groundwater Replenishment Fee, under Section 13 (Utility Rates & Fees) will increase from \$590.63 per acre foot to \$806.50 per acre foot, a 36.5% increase. The rate is increased according to the cost of Metropolitan Water District Tier 1 water that the City must pay for replacement water.

Industrial Waste Discharge Program

The Plan review fees under the Industrial Waste Discharge Program, listed under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) are recommended for an increase above the CPI. These fees and the other fees for the Industrial Waste Discharge Program are charged under a pass through agreement with Los Angeles County and a recommended increase above the CPI brings these fees in line with recent changes in the Los Angeles County fee structure. Other fees under the Industrial Waste Discharge program were reduced as part of the same fee restructuring conducted by the County.

Library Services

The following Library Services fees, listed under Section 7 (Library Services) are recommended for increase above the CPI.

- Library Materials, unreturned: this fee was increased by 2.94% to achieve full cost recovery—this amounts to an increase of \$0.50 cents.
- USB Drive Fee: Floppy disks are no longer used in most computers and Library patrons are not purchasing floppy disks from the Library. Accordingly, floppy disks will no longer be available for sale to the public and the cost has been removed from the Schedule. However, USB drives are utilized by library patrons and such devices will be available for sale to the public based on actual cost, which represents an increase of 50%.

Parking Permits

Certain permits for parking in a preferential parking zone or for overnight parking under Section 9 (Parking Rates) are proposed to be increased above the CPI in order to achieve full cost recovery. These fees are as follows:

- Preferential Parking Permit is proposed to increase from \$29.52 per permit per year, to \$32.50 per permit per year, which represents a 10.1% increase.

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- Preferential Parking - Replacement Permit is proposed to increase from \$29.52 to \$35, which represents an 18.6% increase.
- Resident Overnight Parking - Replacement Permit is proposed to increase from \$29.52 to \$35, which represents an 18.6% increase.

Planning Fees

- Development Agreement Review, Legislative and Code Changes/Project Requiring an EIR: This fee was amended to reflect the cost only for review of a Development Agreement application, whether or not an environmental impact report is required. A flat fee of \$5,000 is requested to reflect the fully burdened cost of approximately 20 hours of staff time in addition to the actual cost of legal and consultant services. Fees for legislative matters such as zone changes, specific plans, and general plan amendments are listed separately and as in the past, include the actual cost of legal and consultant services, as are fees for environmental review.

Tennis Court Fees

The Recreation Division of the Community Services Department is recommending changes associated with the use of tennis courts. The La Cienega Tennis Center recently underwent a renovation of restrooms and locker room facilities, and an on-line court reservation system was introduced. The recommended fee increase for the newly titled annual Tennis Reservation Card will help offset staff and maintenance costs associated with the implementation of these new amenities. The changes in the fees structure are identified below.

- Increase the annual fee for the Tennis Reservation Card to \$8.00 for Residents and \$20 for non-residents.
- Change title of Leisure Services Card fee to Tennis Reservation Card fee.
- Implement changes to Tennis Court fees as follows:

D. NEW FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010/2011

Building & Safety Fees

The following new Building & Safety fees, located under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) are recommended.

- Energy Plan Review and Energy Permit – California Health and Safety Code Sections

18949.29 and 18949.31, allow local agencies to impose fees for construction inspection and plan checks to cover the costs of compliance and enforcement of the California Energy Code (Title 24) of the California Code of Regulations. This new fee is being recommended to cover the costs of processing this type of review and permit.

- **AB717-Training and Education Fee:** AB717 requires local agencies to have specific certifications, training and continuing education for its inspectors, plan examiners, and building officials. Pursuant to the statute the cost of such training and education (projected to be \$35,000 annually) can be passed through and collected through a fee on construction inspection and plan checks. The new fee is 1.2% of building, mechanical, electrical and plumbing permit fees.
- **SB1608-Accessibility Expert:** SB1608 requires local agencies, commencing on July 1, 2010, to employ or retain a certified disability access specialist. Pursuant to the statute, the city may charge or increase permitting and plan check fees to offset the cost of complying with the statute, which is projected to be \$64,091 annually. Accordingly, the new fee is 4% of plan check fee and 3% of permits for all new and greater than 50% remodel of multi-family and commercial properties.
- **Construction Related Parking Permits:** As part of "Other Plan Review and Inspections Fees," listed under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) new fees for Construction Related Parking Permits are recommended to regulate construction parking throughout the development process. They will apply as a condition of the building permit, and will be applied to any construction-related vehicle parking in the city's public right-of-way. This permit will exclude those vehicles already issued permits (Heavy Haul and Public Right-of-Way permits). The new permits will be required to be obtained during the time of the construction-related permit issuance and are good for one month. The new fee is based on project valuation range and is \$130 for less than \$100,000 in project valuation, \$260 for a project valued at between \$101,000 and \$500,000 and \$390 for a project valued at more than \$500,000.
- **Construction Parking Plan Review:** This is a new fee and is set at \$170.45 to achieve cost recovery for one-half the hourly rate of a Senior Plan Review Engineer and one-half the hourly rate of a Senior Building Inspector. This review is part of the efforts to regulate construction parking during the development process.

Community Development Fees

The following new fees associated under Community Development, and located under Section 4 (Copies, Reports, Etc.) are recommended.

- **Electronic Document, Large format (greater than 11 x 17 sheet):** \$25 minimum charge, plus a per sheet charge increase from \$5.30 to \$6, which represents a 13.2% increase. These new and adjusted fees are recommended in order to cover the additional time and printing costs spent on these print requests. These fees are to cover the initial 15 minutes of the fully burdened cost of a Customer Service Representative and printing costs, such

as plotter, ink, toner and paper.

Engineering Fees

New Plan Checking fees for Project Development Engineering Plan Review are recommended in order to achieve full cost recovery of the staff time involved in conducting the review of plans. The new fees are listed under Engineering in Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) and would be as follows:

- Project Development Engineering Plan Review
 - Single family residence (4 hours minimum) \$138.20/hr.
 - Multi - family residence (8 hours minimum) \$138.20/hr.
 - Commercial Development (12 hours minimum) \$138.20/hr.

Fire Department Fees

A new fire prevention inspection fee of \$130.40 per hour, with a minimum of four hours, or \$521.60, is proposed to address special fire inspections that occur outside of regular work hours. This new fee is located under Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) and is recommended in order to address after hours inspections paid for by the contractor. An example is if a contractor needs an inspection before or after normal working hours, the fee would cover overtime cost for the inspector.

Library Services

The following new fees associated with Library Services, and located under Section 7 (Library Services) are recommended.

- Children's Overdue Book Charge: this is a new, separate book fee for children's overdue books and has been set at a lower rate than the Adult Overdue Book Charge.
- Use of Public Scanner: there has been an increase in scanning requests by Library patrons. A new fee of \$1 per scan, for use of the public scanner, is recommended.

Parking Permits

New fees are proposed for certain permits for parking in a preferential parking zone or for overnight parking under Section 9 (Parking Rates) are new fees. These fees are as follows:

- Preferential Parking Permit – Permit renewal application received after September 1: this is a new fee of \$35 per permit.
- Preferential Parking – One-day Guest Permit Issued for Non-business Hours and Residential One-day Guest Permits. These new permits would each be \$2 per day. An Annual Pass for One-day Residential Guest Permits would be set at \$97.50 per year.
- Resident Overnight Parking - Permit renewal application received after September 1: this is a new fee of \$110 per permit. A One-day Guest/Resident Overnight Permit issued for Non-business hours would be \$2, per night.

Planning Fees

There are several new planning fees that are being recommended for the purposes of obtaining full cost recovery reflective of certain reviews and inspections. These reviews and inspections ensure that projects comply with code requirements, conditions of approval and are consistent with the approved plans. The fees located in Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews), are as follows.

- Conformity Review \$294.20
- Planning Inspection Fee
 - Minimum - 2 inspections \$427.20
 - Additional inspections: per inspection \$213.60
- Final Map Review Fee (Planning Only) \$427.20

Police Jail Facility Fee

- Application Fee for Pay to Stay program: The Police Department established a “pay to stay” service for the City’s jail facility last year. The program allows the City to accommodate inmates, who have been court-ordered to serve time, to pay a fee to serve their time in the City’s jail instead of a county jail facility. As part of this program, the Police Department is now recommending the establishment of an Application fee of \$25.00 to cover staff time costs associated with the processing of applicants for the “pay to stay” program.

Pool Discharge Inspections Fee

A new pool discharge inspections fee is recommended, and is listed under Public Works & Transportation, Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) as follows:

- Pool Discharge Inspections (per event): \$100.00

Recreation Services

Staff recommends a new fee for a request to change or transfer registration from one recreation class or camp to another. This new fee, located in Section 10 (Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses), would be a charge to people that sign up for one class or camp and then decide that they want to change their registration to another class or camp. This type of requests happens frequently and involves significant staff time and is recommended as follows:

- Transfer Fee: \$5 (residents and non-residents)

Taxicab Fees

- Transfer Fee (per permit): This is a new fee as Transportation will require that the taxicab company sponsoring the drive be listed on the permit, which will require a transfer if an operator or vehicle moves from one company to another. The new fee is \$79.80.

Transportation

There are several new Transportation fees that are part of the development application process, that are being recommended this year in order to obtain full cost recovery for the work performed by staff. The fees are listed under Public Works & Transportation, Section 6 (Inspections, Permits & Reviews) as follows:

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- Transportation Division Application Review fee \$700
- Transportation Division Concept Review fee \$525
- Transportation Division Plan Check fee \$350

Additionally, the following Transportation-related fees, located under Section 3 (Business Permits), and listed below, have been created as follows:

Valet Parking Attendant Permit

- Transfer Fee (per permit): This is a new fee as Transportation will require that the valet company sponsoring the attendant be listed on the permit, which will require a transfer if an attendant moves from one company to another. The new fee is \$79.80.


E. DELETION OF FEES/TEXT

Obsolete fees that have never been charged or are no longer relevant, or fees that should not have been carried over from the previous years, have been deleted, and are illustrated by a strikethrough on the Schedule.

FISCAL IMPACT

Based on the CPI and revenue analysis, it is estimated that the total adjustments to the comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees, & Charges will achieve approximately \$310,780 in additional cost recovery to the General Fund. This amount is less than would be expected because of reductions in fees proposed by the Fire Department (Brush Clearance Inspection Fee) and Police Department (Vehicle Impound and Release Fee). It must be noted that, with the exception of the \$558,800 in cost recovery projected from the fee changes proposed by the Community Development Department*, all monies resulting from the proposed fees included herein have been included in the proposed budget. As such, any additional reduction of the proposed fees totaling more than \$310,780 would necessitate further and equivalent reductions in expenditures to balance the City's budget.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-R _____

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE
SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES & CHARGES FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR 2010/2011**

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does resolve as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 3-1.1001 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code and Ordinance No. 79-0-1749, the City Council hereby establishes, amends, modifies and fixes, effective July 1, 2010 (except as otherwise set forth herein), fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, exactions, and required payments for municipal services, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2010/11 Rate." The City Council hereby also establishes, amends, modifies and fixes fees for development effective July 19, 2010, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2010/11 Rate." Said designations shall supersede and prevail over any prior provisions concerning the same subjects in any former resolution, motion or other action of this council, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 79-0-1749 shall also prevail over any inconsistent provisions of the Municipal Code. Such fees, permit fees, City services charges and other fees, charges, exactions and required payments for municipal services, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as set forth in Exhibit A shall be included and incorporated into the City's Comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges.

Section 2. The City Council is taking action only on those fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, exactions, and required payments for municipal services, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as modified as set forth in Exhibit A. The remaining taxes, fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, extractions, and required payments for municipal services, inspections, enforcement activities or

for other indicated purposes set forth in the Comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges have not been readopted and remain in place.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of this City.


