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**Item A. APPROVAL OF A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$159,822.78 TO THEODORE ROBINS FORD INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIX FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE INTERCEPTOR SEDANS.**

### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a purchase order in the amount of \$159,822.78 to Theodore Robins Ford, Inc. for the purchase of six Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor (CVPI) sedans.

### **INTRODUCTION**

An annual evaluation of the City's vehicle and equipment fleet determined that six public safety vehicles have either met or exceeded their life expectancies.

### **DISCUSSION**

Procurement staff requests waiver of formal bid procedures recommending purchase of these vehicles by using the provision in the City's purchasing codes that allows the City to utilize the purchase contract between the City of San Jose, CA and Theodore Robins Ford, Inc. of Costa Mesa. Theodore Robins Ford, Inc. has provided a price quote extending the same terms and conditions to the City of Beverly Hills, including the same prices, terms, and conditions that are stipulated in its contract with the City of San Jose.

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
**FISCAL IMPACT**
