INTRODUCTION

At the request of Councilmember Krasne, this item was scheduled and briefly discussed at the January 11, 2011 Study Session. The information provided for the January 11, 2011 meeting was different than the actual subject of concern, so the item was continued to today's meeting with the correct information.

DISCUSSION

For Beverly Hills Board and Commission appointments, the Beverly Hills Municipal Code §2-2-106D states:

"membership shall terminate automatically if a member ceases to reside in the city, unless residence is not required for membership or unless a member has temporarily ceased to reside in the city because of unusual circumstance or hardship, has not purchased a home outside the city which the member is residing, intends to move back into the city, and has not previously ceased to reside in the city at any time while serving on the commission. For the purposes of this subsection "temporarily" means a period not exceeding six (6) months starting from the date a member ceased residence in the city."

RECOMMENDATION

City Council concurrence on the residency requirement for Board and Commission appointments is needed.
