Vice Mayor Brucker invited the Councilmembers to make brief comments to retiring Councilmember Krasne. Councilmember Krasne thanked Joel Pressman, the Academy, and City Manager Kolin and staff. She congratulated newly elected Councilmembers Lili Bosse and Julian Gold. She spoke about her future plans, and thanked the community for the opportunity to serve. Mayor Delshad presented Councilmember Krasne with letters and certificates of recognition from Congressman Henry Waxman, Senator Diane Feinstein and Assemblymember Mike Feuer, and a Key to the City. He acknowledged Councilmember Krasne's husband Jim Krasne and her son David.

Vice Mayor Brucker invited the Councilmembers to make brief comments to retiring Mayor Delshad. Mayor Delshad presented a video highlighting his life journey, inspirations, and accomplishments during his term on the Council and as Mayor, and the year in review. He thanked his fellow Councilmembers, Vice Mayor Brucker, City staff, his family especially his wife Lonnie.
