RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt the resolution amending the fees and charges for Fiscal Year 2011/2012.

INTRODUCTION

The City levies a range of permit fees, charges, rental and use fees, taxes and other fees or payments, which are listed in a comprehensive schedule called "Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges" (hereinafter "Schedule of Fees & Charges" or "Schedule"). The Schedule contains the following sections:

- Section 1 – Ambulance & Alarm Fees
- Section 2 – Appeals & Hearings
- Section 3 – Business Permits
- Section 4 – Copies, Reports, etc.
- Section 5 – Facilities Use Fees
- Section 6 – Inspections, Permits & Reviews
- Section 7 – Library Services
- Section 8 – Parking Citations

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- Section 9 – Parking Permits
- Section 10 – Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses
- Section 11 – Special Events & Filming
- Section 12 – Taxes
- Section 13 – Utility Rates & Fees

Maintaining a comprehensive book with all the various fees, charges and taxes ensures that the City provides the public with one document that contains all city fees rather than providing the information in several documents or in piecemeal form. In addition, the Schedule is available on the City's website. Although the City reviews the Schedule yearly, there are times when revisions are made to certain fees during the year. When that occurs, the comprehensive book is updated.

With the passage of Proposition 4 that became Article XIII B of the State Constitution, fee services cannot exceed the "costs reasonably borne" by the City in delivery of such services. In compliance with this State law, the City periodically performs a full cost study to confirm current costs of services and to recommend cost recovery levels for these fee-based programs, the last cost study was performed in 2007 by the Revenue & Cost Specialists, LLC consulting group. A new cost study is planned for FY2011/12.

In accordance with Section 3-1.1001 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code ("Municipal Code") and Ordinance No. 79-0-1749, City taxes and fees set forth in Title 3 of the Municipal Code are adjusted annually, based upon the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the preceding twelve months. Taxes are contained in Section 12 of the schedule.

Adjustments to the fees and charges contained in the Schedule are set by City Council resolution. At this time, the only sections under consideration by the City Council are Ambulance & Alarm Fees, Appeals & Hearings, Business Permits, Copies, Reports, Etc., Facilities Use Fees, Inspections, Permits & Reviews, Library Services, Parking Permits, Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses, Special Events & Filming and Taxes and certain water service connection charges.

In June 2010, water and solid waste utility rates as set forth in Section 13 were adopted by Ordinance No. 10-O-2584. As such, these rates are not part of the proposed Resolution before the City Council.

Exhibit A to the Resolution (Attachment 4) contains the fees, charges and rates for Fiscal Year 2011/2012 that are to be adopted. Fees have been adjusted to reflect an increase of .7% based on the November increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers in the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County, CA area. Attachment 3 contains a redline document of fees that have been revised. In some cases, the fees and/or charges are adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more accurate distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI. Fees that increased above the CPI are shown in green. Fees that have been reduced are shown in red. New fees are shown in blue. Some fees have stayed the same. Strikeouts indicate deletion of text that is no longer relevant and/or clean up. Except as otherwise indicated, all fees are scheduled to become effective July 1, 2011. The Vegetation Management Program fees, managed by the Fire Department, will become effective on January 1, 2012 so that fee increases do not take place in the middle of the inspection process.

DISCUSSION

A. FEES ADJUSTED BY THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)

The fees and charges set forth in Exhibit "A" to the Resolution have been increased by 0.7%, except as noted below. The fees that were not adjusted in line with the CPI are further discussed below.

For ease of collection, fees have been rounded to the nearest dime (\$0.10), with the exception of the following:

- 1) Fees charged by Community Services, which were rounded to the nearest dollar in response to the staff's and the public's request that the City's fees be rounded off when and where it is possible.
- 2) Fees that are less than \$1.00.

B. FEES INCREASED ABOVE CPI

As stated above, some fees are adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more accurate distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI. With the exception of rounding to the nearest dime, the fees that are being increased above the CPI are shown on the Schedule in green and are outlined below.

Copies, Reports, etc. (Section 4)

The following fees are recommended for increase above the CPI. These proposed increases are to achieve full cost recovery.

Community Development Department

- General Plan - The proposed increase is from \$25.30 to \$36.70, or 45.1%. The fee increase is to recover the full cost of 364 pages at \$00.40 for the first page and \$00.10 each for the following pages.

Police Department

- Daily Storage Fee (Impounded Vehicles & Motorcycles) – The proposed increase is from \$40.77 to \$42.81, or 5%, in order to recover the additional costs associated with the City's Vehicle Impound Storage Program, which is approximately \$11,000 per year.
- Vehicle Auction Purchase Deposit – The proposed increase is from \$400.00 to \$428.00 or 7.0%. This provides for the recovery of 10 full days of Daily Storage fees from vehicles mandated by state law to remain in impound for 10 days following their sale at auction.

Inspections, Permits & Reviews (Section 6)

The following development fees are recommended for increase above the CPI.

Community Development - Planning

- In-Lieu Parking Seismic Upgrade Incentive (per space)
 - Tier II – from \$10,428.20 to \$10,972.97, or 5.224%
 - Tier III – from \$19,658.40 to \$20,685.35, or 5.224%

These proposed fees are adjusted based on the January 2011 CPI for the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index for the Los Angeles Area.

Community Development - Engineering

- Final Parcel Map – from \$3,100.00 to \$3,200.00, or 3.2%
- Final Tract Map – from \$3,100.00 to \$3,200.00, or 3.2%

These proposed fees were increased to include the messenger fee for submitting the final map to the Los Angeles County, Department of Public Works.

- Plan Check – Multi Family Residence. Hourly fee increased from \$138.20 to \$139.20 with an 8 hour minimum. This increase equals 2.7%.

This increase is suggested to keep the hourly rate consistent with the 2 other plan checking fees which also increased by \$1 but have minimums of 4 and/or 12 hours. The percentage increase for the 2 other plan checking fees is consistent with the CPI, .7%.

Library Services (Section 7)

The following Library Services fees are recommended for increase above the CPI. The Library Division has researched other libraries in regards to commercial use of images, and based the proposed rates on the going rates that other libraries charge.

Library Collection Photograph Reproduction Fees as follows:

- Handling Postage – U.S. Mail (First Class/Priority Mail) – from \$3.00 to \$10.00, or 233.3%. This proposed fee increase is to charge one standard fee for all handling/postage. Separate fees for air mail and mailing tubes are suggested to be eliminated.
- Commercial Use Fees – The following commercial use fees are proposed to increase based on rates charged at other libraries. These fees are charged to customers who desire to utilize property (such as photographs) from the City's photo collection.
 - Advertising & product design, from \$151.00 to \$250.00, or 65.6%
 - Commercial Décor, per image, one time use: from \$151.00 to \$200.00, or 32.5%
 - Commercial Décor, usage fee for multiple copies per image: from \$302.00 to \$400.00, or 32.5%
 - Commercial Media, images for use in CD-ROMs, television, video and films, one time use: from \$126.00 to \$150.00, or 19.0%
 - Educational Media: from \$25.00 to \$50.00, or 100%

Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses (Section 10)

The fees below are contained in are recommended for increases as follows:

Community Services

Tennis Reservation Card fee for residents for the use of the La Cienega Tennis Center is proposed to increase from \$8.00 to \$10.00, or 25%. The La Cienega Tennis Center recently underwent a renovation of restrooms and locker room facilities, and an on-line court reservation system was introduced. The increased fee will help offset staff and maintenance costs associated with the implementation of these new amenities and for the use of the City's facilities. The increase will provide \$3,500 towards recovery of the City's costs. Also, staff does not believe that this increase will dissuade patrons from renewing their reservation card. Beverly Hills court rates match or exceed current fees charged by tennis facilities in the area and Beverly Hills provides one of the finest public

tennis facilities in Southern California. (Attached is a survey of rates at tennis facilities in the area).

Community Development

Trapping Rates, for delivery and set up of traps, any type – from \$125.00 to \$150.00, or 20.00%. These rates are set by the trapping service contractor and are only charged to those persons who request the service.

C. FEES REMAINING THE SAME, REDUCED, OR INCREASED BELOW THE CPI

Obsolete fees that are no longer relevant have been deleted. As to remaining fees, some fees will stay the same, for example, because the fee is capped by state or federal law or the fee is a pass through from a third party (such as the County). Examples include but are not limited to bingo permits fees, vehicle lien sale processing fees, repossession fees, concealed weapons fees and passport processing fees. Youth Organized Sport Fees are suggested to remain at current levels.

In some instances, the fee is the same so as not to reduce business. Examples include but are not limited to, the pay to stay application fee and jail facility fee. These fees are based on fee surveys of agencies in the region and an increase in the fee may reduce business and be counter-productive. Another example is the passport photo fee recommended to remain at \$11.00. An increase may reduce the number of passport photo requests. The Police Department's Correctable Citation Sign-off fee is recommended to remain the same at \$15.00. An increase in this fee may reduce the number of service requests. Last, the Sworn Police Personnel and Traffic Control Officer rates for Special Event coverage are recommended to remain at current levels to maintain the City's competitive edge in attracting special events in the City.

In some instances, fees have been reduced. The following provides a summary

Facilities Use Fees (Section 5)

- Adult Trolley Fares are reducing from \$10.10 to \$10.00 for ease of collection. However, children's fares are recommended to remain at \$5.00.

Inspections, Permits & Reviews (Section 6)

In pursuing streamlining of services, the following development fees have been reduced as a result of processing efficiencies:

- Architectural Review & Design Review, Commission Level Revision fees are suggested to be reduced from \$5,955.30 to \$4,764.20 and \$6,210.30 to \$4,968.20 respectively. It is suggested that these fees be reduced due to efficiency enhancements made to the application process. Specifically, fewer staff members are involved in the application review and processing, report preparation, attendance and management of the Architectural Commission. By consolidating these operations and shifting responsibilities, the division was able to eliminate processing time from each application. A note has been added to indicate that the fee covers two meetings only. Projects acted on by the commission in one meeting are proposed to receive a refund of one half the original fee. Subsequent reviews are proposed to be one half the original

application fee per additional meeting, after two meetings. Revenue reductions of \$88,000 for Architectural review fees and \$56,000 for Design review fees are estimated.

- Parking Covenant Amendment Review (Section 6, Inspections, Permits & Reviews) is proposed to be reduced from \$11,544.60 to \$2,310.00. This reduction will provide for cost recovery of 10 hours of Associate Planner time. An hourly staff rate will be added to this fee after 10 hours of review. Planning has not done this type of review to date, so there is no expected impact to revenues with this reduction.
- The Common Interest Development fee is proposed to be reduced from \$16,748.10 to \$14,232.10. This will allow for cost recovery and align the fee with the Tentative Parcel Map Review fee. After processing six of these applications in the past few years it was determined that this requires the same effort as placed on Tentative Map applications. As this application is not processed very often, there is no expected impact to revenues with this reduction.

In addition, there has been some clean-up to the schedule and fees that are capped by state law are now listed as a reference to the relevant state statute (such as the heavy haul permits).

D. NEW FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011/2012

Business Permits (Section 3)

A late renewal fee for a commercial valet permit is recommended at \$100 for late renewal, plus an additional \$18 for each day a permit is late. This would allow the operator to continue service without interruption for the use of public right of way for its operations while the renewal application is being submitted and reviewed. The charges estimated for this year are approximately \$9,500 and then expected to decrease in future years.

Facilities Use Fees (Section 5)

The following new Facilities Use Charges are recommended;

- Greystone Estate Use Charges (Interior Use) – Based on research of similar venues throughout the Southern California area (attachment 2), staff is recommending the following fees for indoor use of the City's property at Greystone Mansion. This will be the first time indoor use of the mansion will be allowed for private groups. Demand will be monitored, patrons not choosing Greystone will be surveyed to determine the reasons for not selecting Greystone, and rates may be adjusted in the future.

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- Bail Bond Advertising is recommended at \$50.00 per month. This new charge would allow licensed bail bond companies to utilize the City's property and pay to be included on an advertisement board near the inmate pay phones in the Jail facility. The charges estimated for this year are approximately \$6,000.
- Trolley Promotional Fares have been added. These new promotional/reduced fares are intended to increase ridership. The proposed promotional fares are \$5.00 for an Adult and \$1.00 for Children under 12. The standard, non-promotional fares are \$10.00 for an Adult and \$5.00 for Children under 12.

Inspections, Permits & Reviews (Section 6)

The following new Building & Safety fees are recommended;

- A new deposit for urban design review, of \$2,500.00 is proposed for projects 25,000 sq. ft. or greater, with potential impacts to aesthetics.
- The Multiple Application Fee is proposed to be revised to state that the most expensive application will be charged at full price, with each subsequent application being charged the multiple application fee. This revision is to bring clarity to the fee and not expected to generate any additional revenue.
- In a cost recovery effort, a new View Restoration Application Fee is proposed at a rate of \$8,465.60 plus staff hourly rate after 18.5 hours of review from filing, a new Medical Use Inventory Review fee is proposed at \$2,310.00, plus staff hourly rate after 10 hours of review from filing, and a Water Well Application Fee is proposed at a rate of \$8,626.60. These fees will recover staff time for processing these applications at an amount estimated at \$150,000 in revenue.
- A Monument Inspection fee of \$380.00 is proposed. Monument Inspection is part of the final map process, and handled and charged by RKA (City's Consultant) to the City. This passes along to the customer the City's cost for this service.

Special Events & Filming (Section 11)

The following new Filming fees are recommended;

- The addition of a rush request fee of \$50.00 for filming permits. The City's policy for film requests are that applications are to be received 48 hours prior to actual filming, however the Permit Office occasionally receives last minute requests. In order to accommodate rush requests, and the staff overtime that can result, it is being recommended that a new fee be established for requests that are submitted less than 48 hours in advance of filming. This fee is expected to generate \$1,000 in cost recovery per year.

LEED Debris Processing

The following new fee is recommended:

In order to achieve a LEED Platinum Certification rating, a 95% diversion rate is necessary. For those customers who are going through this process, a processing fee of \$20 will be charged for the paperwork and processing necessary to document this activity. This is a fee imposed by Crown Disposal and is a pass-through and will only be

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assessed if requested by a customer.

FISCAL IMPACT

Based on the CPI and revenue analysis, it is estimated that the total adjustments to the comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees, & Charges will achieve approximately \$180,000 in additional cost recovery to the General Fund. This additional revenue has been included in the proposed budget. As such, reductions of the proposed fees may require offsetting reductions in expenditures to balance the City's budget.

RESOLUTION NO. 11-R _____

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE
SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES & CHARGES FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR 2011/2012**

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby establishes, amends, modifies and fixes, effective July 1, 2011 (except as otherwise set forth herein), fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, and required payments for municipal services, use of City property, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2011/12 Rate." The City Council hereby also establishes, amends, modifies and fixes fees for development effective July 1, 2011, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2011/12 New Rate." Said designations in Exhibit A shall supersede and prevail over any prior provisions concerning the same item in any former resolution, motion or other action of this council, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 79-0-1749 shall also prevail over any inconsistent provisions of the Municipal Code. Such fees, permit fees, City services charges and other fees, charges, and required payments for municipal services, use of City property, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as set forth in Exhibit A shall be included and incorporated into the City's Comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges.

Section 2. Notwithstanding Section 1, the fees for the "Vegetation Management Program" under "Inspections, Permits & Reviews" shall be effective January 1, 2012.

Section 3. The City Council is taking action only on those fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, and required payments for municipal services, use of City property, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as modified as

set forth in Exhibit A. The (i) remaining fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, and required payments for municipal services, use of City property, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes as set forth in the current Comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges; and (ii) fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, and required payments for municipal services, use of city property, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes as set forth in any resolution(s) adopted by the City Council, that are not listed in Exhibit A to this Resolution, have not been readopted or revised and remain in place at the current rate.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of this City.
