The Regular City Council meeting was held in the Council Chambers at 7:00 pm.

E. CONTINUED AND NEW BUSINESS

1. AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC ASSOCIATED WITH REGIONAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS SMART CLASSROOM PROJECT, BID NO. 13-03;

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, CITY ATTORNEY AND FIRE CHIEF TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC, FOR ALL HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, EQUIPMENT, AND SERVICES RELATED TO THE BID; AND

AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF A PURCHASE ORDER IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED THE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) FEDERAL GRANT FUNDING OF \$1,537,830 FOR THESE GOODS AND SERVICES. Comment: Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract to CDW Government, associated with Bid No. 13-03 for the Regional Fire Departments Smart Classroom Project; authorize the City Manager, City Attorney and Fire Chief to negotiate and execute an Agreement between the City of Beverly Hills and CDW Government for all hardware, software, equipment and services related to the bid; and authorize approval of a purchase order to CDW Government in an amount not-to-exceed the authorized UASI grant funding of \$1,537,830 for these goods and services.

Chief Information Officer David Schirmer and Deputy Fire Chief Mark Embrey jointly presented a PowerPoint report that provided a brief background on the project, success stories, grant funding, the smart classroom strategy, benefits, process, and next steps/plans.

Councilmember Gold inquired about funding and maintenance cost of the project, expansion of membership to other cities, videotaping the training for future class use, and the possibility of selling the educational content of training videos. He congratulated the Fire Chief and staff for their work. Councilmember Bosse congratulated staff for leading the way and for a job well done. Councilmember Brucker congratulated staff for spearheading the project and setting the example. Vice Mayor Mirisch asked for a confirmation that funding is from a grant and not from the City. He also asked whether the City of Beverly Hills will take over the other cities' work since the grant was awarded to the City. Mayor Brien explained that the UASI is a regional grant which impacts large urban areas. He congratulated the Fire Chief and staff for an excellent job.

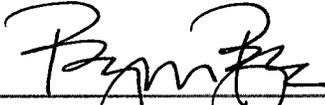
