Subject: Proclamation Recognizing May as Older Americans Recognition Month and Recognition of Beverly Hills Older American Maria Heilpern

INTRODUCTION

In national recognition of the month of May as Older Americans Month, the City of Beverly Hills is provided the opportunity to recognize seniors for their valuable contribution to society. City Council is invited to proclaim May as Older Americans Recognition Month and recognize resident Maria Heilpern as this year's Beverly Hills Older American.

DISCUSSION

For the past 26 years, the City has paid tribute to Older Americans Month by selecting an outstanding Older American of the Year to represent the City at an Annual Older Americans Recognition Day Awards Program held this year on Wednesday, May 25 at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion in downtown Los Angeles. Sponsored by Los Angeles County and the Los Angeles County Commission on Aging, Beverly Hills will be one of 88 cities in Los Angeles County recognizing senior adults.

This year, staff selected Maria Heilpern for four years of volunteer contributions to the community and the Beverly Hills Active Adult Club Board.
