INTRODUCTION

The Boy Scouts of America - Troop 33 of Beverly Hills is requesting assistance in storing their Boy Scout House. The land on which the House stands is primarily owned by the Los Angeles Country Club, which has not renewed the Boy Scout's lease, and the House will need to be relocated immediately. The Boy Scouts are requesting assistance from the City in finding an area to temporarily relocate the House until a permanent location is found, and Staff has determined two viable options for the temporary storage around the 336 Foothill Road property. The Mayor has requested that this item be brought forth to the City Council for discussion.

DISCUSSION

The Los Angeles Country Club (LACC) provided the Boy Scouts up until April 15, 2016 to devise a funded and viable plan for moving the Scout House off the property. With the lease already expired, LACC has not yet issued a formal eviction notice, but the Boy Scouts anticipate that it could be issued soon. As a result, the Boy Scouts will need to find a location to temporarily hold the House until a permanent location is found.

The Troop has formed a 501c3, called the Beverly Hills Scout House Association to assist in raising funds for the relocation and currently has commitments of approximately \$49,000 to move the House. It should be noted that the main source of these funds are in a single charitable trust and can only be used to relocate the Scout House to a usable permanent location. Should a permanent location not be immediately found, the funds may be used to relocate the Scout House to a temporary storage location provided that the City guarantees a future useable permanent location within 2 years. City Staff has explored a number of sites to store the House and has determined two potentially viable options. Both options are around the 336 Foothill Road property and are identified in the attached map.

It is currently unknown the exact method and potential routes for the relocation of the House to 336 Foothill Road. It is anticipated that some of this information will become available at the time of the Council meeting, as the Boy Scouts will be meeting with their contractor before this time. The moving of the House will require sizable trucks traveling through City streets at night. Depending on the finalized plan to move the House, City permits and a police escort may need to be acquired. City permits may include a public right-of-way permit, demolition permit, foundation permit and a street use/encroachment permit. Any moving related expenses, such as fence removal and replacement, will be paid for by the Boy Scouts.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is currently no fiscal impact to the City, as the Boy Scouts will be paying for the relocation of the Scout House, any related moving expenses and permits. Depending on the finalized plan, permits could cost approximately \$2,200 and a police escort could cost somewhere between \$1,000 to \$4,000.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council discuss the potential of temporarily storing the Beverly Hills Boy Scout House for a maximum of 2 years on City property around the 336 Foothill Road location, with a guarantee that the City will locate a future usable permanent location within this timeframe.

The Beverly Hills Scout House

Dear Mayor Mirisch and City Council members,

I need your help in saving the Beverly Hills Scout House (designed by the same master architect that designed City Hall) has served our community for over 80 years. The BSHS is currently administered by the Beverly Hills Scout House Association ("BHSHA"), a 5013c non-profit organization. The Scout House has historically supported a broad range of scouting activities in Beverly Hills including Boy Scout Troop 33, Cub Scout Pack 100, and a number of Brownies and Girl Scout units representing many thousands of youths over the years. I personally have deep ties to the Scout House where I earned the rank of Eagle Scout, as did my son this year, and where I now serve as Scoutmaster of Troop 33 and as President of the BHSHA.

As you are aware, the BHSHA was unable to reach an agreement with the Los Angeles Country Club ("LACC") on extending the Scout House lease. The LACC fixed April 15th, 2016 for us to devise a workable plan, including proof of funding, to move the structures to a new location. We were able to secure funding (proof attached hereto as Exhibit A), but were unable to secure a new piece of land. Had we met the first condition, the LACC fixed July 15th, 2016 for us to physically complete the move.

We need the City to become an active participant in saving these historic structures which have been part of the fabric of our community for so long and to which so many residents have strong emotional ties. For example, a petition to the City to save the

scout house garnered 420 signatures within a few days, including a number of our most distinguished residents. A copy of that petition is attached hereto as Exhibit B. In addition, a number of past mayors and City Council members have expressed strong support for our efforts. As such we believe there is widespread support among the Beverly Hills community for this effort.

We are asking the City government to lend the full weight of its skills, knowledge, expertise and political clout in finding a permanent location for the Scout House. We are open to any and all options as to a permanent location, including all public and even private lands of which the city might deem suitable. Failing, that we ask that the Mayor's office and City Council:


- Direct City staff to work with us to create a viable plan to relocate the Scout House in a time frame acceptable to the LACC;
- Assist us in convincing the LACC via a letter of stated support from the City to look past the missed deadline and grant the time needed to relocate with your aid;
- If it is necessary to relocate the Scout Houses into a "storage only" area to commit to helping us find a new home and to see them placed and in use again within no more than two years.

The BSHSA has raised \$49,000 towards this effort. The source of these funds is a single charitable trust provided by Beverly Hills resident Admiral Frank E. Raab. Admiral Raab has stipulated that the funds must be used to relocate the Scout House to a useable permanent location. Failing that, the funds may be used to relocate the Scout House to a temporary storage location (quoted cost of \$45,000; Brandt House & Building Movers) provided that the City guarantees a future useable permanent location within 2 years. You understand that as a volunteer organization it is quite difficult (but clearly not impossible) for us to raise large sums of money and we do not wish to see

these dollars wasted. We are confident that were the City to grant us a permanent location, we could raise the additional amounts needed to fully restore the Scout House to pristine status, including a new foundation, replacement of the chimney, and other needed improvements.

Our efforts are motivated by our belief in the core mission of the Cub, Girl and Boy programs which develop leaders and foster a sense of community and civic pride. Scouts have contributed countless community service hours to the city (e.g., creation of the community garden at Greystone; assembling park benches for use along Santa Monica; rebuilding bridges in Franklin Canyon; creating educational aids for the special education program in our schools). We believe the Scout House is an integral part of this mission.


