RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council move to approve a resolution authorizing the submittal of an application for payment programs and related authorizations for CalRecycle.

INTRODUCTION

The Beverage Container Recycling Payment Program is a competitive payment program through State-sponsored Cal Recycle in which the City applies for funding annually and receives a disbursement based on available funding for the program. The goal of CalRecycle's beverage container recycling program is to reach and maintain an 80 percent recycling rate for all California Refund Value (CRV) beverage containers – aluminum, glass, plastic and bi-metal. Projects implemented by cities and counties will assist in reaching and maintaining this goal.

DISCUSSION

Each year the City submits a request for funding to address recycling challenges, aid in increasing beverage container collection and reduce litter in the waste stream.


As a part of the Solid Waste Conservation Program, staff is requesting funding to help support the bin replacement program and outreach for recycling. In 2014 the Solid Waste program began a container replacement project to replace containers and lids throughout the City's alleys. Funding will be used to offset the cost of the graphic mold

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and hot stamp label instructions for container usage. Historically the City receives around \$9,000.00 annually. In FY 2015/16, the City received \$ 9,390.00.

FISCAL IMPACT

Disbursement is based on available funding for the program. It is anticipated the City will be notified of the award amount in September 2016.

RESOLUTION NO. 16-R-_____

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT PROGRAMS
AND RELATED AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE CALRECYCLE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq., 14581, and 42023.1(g), the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has established various payment programs to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the payment programs; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering payment programs require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the payment program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Beverly Hills hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City is hereby authorized to submit an application to CalRecycle for any and all payment programs offered.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement and secure payment.

Section 3. This authorization is effective until rescinded by the City Council.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and its certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.


