RECOMENDATION

Staff recommends that City Council adopt the resolution authorizing the acceptance of grant funding under the federal Bulletproof Vest Partnership. Staff also recommends that the City Council move to appropriate \$3,059.83 for the purchase of ballistic vests as follows:

INTRODUCTION

On May 11, 2015, the City submitted an application for the FY2015 Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP). The City received notice from the Bureau of Justice Assistance that the City was awarded \$3,059.83 from this federal program.

DISCUSSION

In 2003, 2008, 2009, 2011 and in 2013, the Police Department participated in the BVP to replace ballistic vests which had exceeded their life expectancy. The department anticipates the need to purchase 10 vests for police officers between April 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017. The FY 2015 BVP grant will be used to assist the City with these purchases.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost for purchasing 10 ballistic vests is approximately \$7,100. The FY2015 BVP grant funds will be used in conjunction with the Police Department's Fund 40 equipment replacement budget to purchase these vests. The BVP will reimburse the City for up to 50% of the costs associated with these purchases, up to a maximum of \$3,059.83. The department will follow the City's procurement policy for these purchases.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT UNDER
THE FEDERAL BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Bureau of Justice Assistance (“BJA”) administers the FY 2015 Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program (“BVP”) which is a grant program that reimburses cities for up to fifty percent of the costs associated with purchasing ballistic vests between April 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017.

Section 2. The City of Beverly Hills (“City”) hereby appoints the City Manager or his designee to accept the FY 2015 BVP grant to assist with funding ballistic vests purchases between April 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017. The City, the City Manager or his designee is also authorized to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for administration of the FY 2015 BVP grant.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.




