### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the City Council approve blanket purchase orders to MV Transportation, Inc. for a not-to-exceed amount of \$750,169 for management, operations, and maintenance of the City's Senior Transit Services for Fiscal Year 2016-17 and Keolis Transit America for a not-to-exceed amount of 160,001 for administration of the City's taxi subsidy program for Fiscal Year 2016-17. This is an administrative update.

### INTRODUCTION

The transit services provided by MV Transportation, Inc. include, but are not limited to, free curb-to-curb shared dial-a-ride transportation for medical appointments and personal appointments, trolley tours; on-demand special City department charters. Keolis Transit America administers the City's taxi subsidy program, which provides discounted taxi fare coupons for resident seniors and qualifying disabled persons.

**DISCUSSION**

In June 2015, the Beverly Hills City Council approved Agreement No. 243-15 with MV Transportation, Inc., and Agreement 242-15 with Keolis Transit America for three-year extensions for fiscal years 2016-2018, to continue to management and operation of the senior transportation programs.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The transit programs for resident seniors and disabled persons are fully funded with Proposition-A and Proposition-C local return transportation grant funds. Special charters requested by City departments are charged directly to the requesting department.
