RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting a donation of \$2,000 from the Beverly Hills Rotary Community Foundation and appropriate funds in the amount of \$2,000 for purchase of a fully equipped Police Patrol bicycle.

INTRODUCTION

Rotary Club President Michael Blumenfeld has presented a donation to the City on behalf of the community service organization, to facilitate purchase of this public safety equipment.

DISCUSSION

The Bicycle Unit of the Police Field Services Division, Patrol Bureau, is being revitalized to deal with quality of life issues impacting the Community, such as with the Homeless Outreach program. To immediately meet this task, the Police Department has trained approximately 20 additional officers in bicycle patrol techniques with in-house instructors. These officers will be collaterally deployed, as necessary, in teams. These additional bicycles will replace equipment that has had eight to ten years of service and will be used by the Patrol Bicycle officers.

FISCAL IMPACT

An appropriation of \$2,000 is requested to fund purchase of a police bicycle. The City has received a donation of \$2,000 from the Beverly Hills Rotary Community Foundation to offset this expenditure.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS ACCEPTING A DONATION OF
\$2,000 FROM THE BEVERLY HILLS ROTARY
COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR A POLICE
BICYCLE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR
PURCHASE OF THIS EQUIPMENT

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Beverly Hills Rotary Community Foundation has offered the City a donation of \$2,000 for the purchase of one fully equipped bicycle for the Police Patrol Bureau.

Section 2. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 37354 and 37355, the City may accept such gift and may put such gift to such uses as the City Council prescribes.

Section 3. The City Council hereby accepts the donation for the purchase of a bicycle for the Police Patrol Bureau from the Beverly Hills Rotary Community Foundation.

Section 4. Appropriation of funds in the amount of \$2,000 is authorized as follows:

Section 5. Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.




