RECOMMENDATION

Receive the report from the City Council Liaison Committee to the Beverly Hills Unified School District regarding the terms for renewal of the agreement between the City and the Beverly Hills School District for the provision, use and maintenance of educational, recreational and community facilities and programs; discuss the terms; and provide direction to the City Attorney's office to draft an agreement consistent with the terms.

INTRODUCTION

The City Council/Beverly Hills Unified School District Liaison Committee has been meeting for several months to discuss the renewal of the Joint Powers Agreement between the City and the Beverly Hills Unified School District. Mayor Brucker and Vice-Mayor Fenton are the City Council liaisons.

As the City and the community are aware, the agreement between the City and the School District, commonly known as the "JPA", provides the City with the use of educational and recreational facilities owned by the District to enable the City to carry out programs that benefit the residents. These facilities include, but are not limited to, athletic fields, playgrounds, auditoriums, classrooms and swimming facilities.

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DISCUSSION

The current JPA expires on June 30, 2008. The current fiscal year payment to the District for the use of the facilities is \$8.4 million. The City Council/Beverly Hills Unified School District Liaison Committee has been meeting for several months to discuss the renewal and its terms. The City Council Liaison Committee will be presenting their report and recommendation to the City Council for review and discussion. Upon direction from the City Council, the City Attorney's office will draft an agreement to be brought to the City Council for approval at the July 8, 2008 City Council meeting.
