### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting a donation of \$2,800 from the Santa Clarita Community College District and appropriate funds in the amount of \$2,800 for the Police Department's Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) program.

### **INTRODUCTION**

The Santa Clarita Community College District has presented a donation to the City to facilitate purchases for the D.A.R.E. program.

### **DISCUSSION**


The Police Department's School Resource Officers provide drug awareness courses in the Beverly Hills Unified School District (BHUSD). In addition to providing officers to the BHUSD, the department is also the training center for D.A.R.E. officers throughout the state. The donation will be used to further train the department's School Resource Officers in the D.A.R.E. curriculum.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

An appropriation of \$2,800 is requested to fund training expenses for the D.A.R.E. program. The City has received a donation of \$2,800 from the Santa Clarita Community College District to offset these expenditures.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$2,800 FROM THE SANTA CLARITA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT FOR THE D.A.R.E. PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR USE BY THE D.A.R.E. PROGRAM

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Santa Clarita Community College District has offered the City a donation of \$2,800 to be used for the Police Department’s D.A.R.E. program (“DARE Program”).

Section 2. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 37354 and 37355, the City may accept such gift and may put such gift to such uses as the City Council prescribes.

Section 3. The City Council hereby accepts the donation for use by the Police Department’s DARE Program.

Section 4. Appropriation of funds in the amount of \$2,800 is authorized as follows:

Section 5. The City hereby appoints the City Manager or his designee as agent of the City of Beverly Hills to accept the donated funding and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to purchase orders and payment requests, which may be necessary for acquisition of this equipment.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.


