RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution approving the Conflict of Interest Code for the Design Review Commission, Health and Safety Commission, and Groundwater Management Plan Technical Committee, as well as amendments to the Conflict of Interest Code for Administrative Services, Policy and Management, City Attorney, City Clerk, Fire, Police, Community Services, Information Technology, Public Works and Transportation, Community Development, Architectural Commission, Fine Art Commission, Human Relations Commission, Planning Commission, Public Works Commission, Recreation and Parks Commission, Solicitations Advisory Commission, and Traffic and Parking Commission.

INTRODUCTION

Section 87300 of the Political Reform Act requires that every government agency adopt and enforce a Conflict of Interest Code which lists the positions designated to file the Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests and their disclosure categories. In addition, Government Code Section 87306 requires that agencies amend its Conflict of Interest Code in the event of changed circumstances such as the creation of new positions, relevant changes in the duties assigned to existing positions, and/or deletion of positions. The City Council, as the City of Beverly Hills' code reviewing body, is being requested to review and approve the amendments and changes being herewith presented.

DISCUSSION

Each year the City's departments review their Conflict of Interest Code and submit a list of employees designated to file the Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests. Similarly, the City's various Commissions review their Conflict of Interest Code biennially. The amendments presented in the attached exhibits are a result of staffing and disclosure changes.

Since their creation in June 1, 1999, April 20, 2004, and August 7, 2007, the Groundwater Management Plan Technical Committee, Design Review Commission, and the Health and Safety Commission, respectively, have not adopted a Conflict of Interest Code. The attached Conflict of Interest Code for these Committee and Commissions are being presented for approval for the first time.

Upon approval of the Conflict of Interest Codes, all designated employees, Commissioners and Committee members will be given a copy of their respective Conflict of Interest Code and Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests for filing by the designated deadline.
