Item A. APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AND PACIFIC COAST CABLING, INC. D.B.A. PCC NETWORK SOLUTIONS FOR COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES RELATED TO CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS; AND,

APPROVAL OF A CHANGE PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000 FOR THESE SERVICES FOR A TOTAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$90,000

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the proposed amendment for additional cabling services during upcoming CIP projects including the Police Facility remodel and expansion of the Emergency Operations Center, in the amount of \$45,000 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$90,000.

INTRODUCTION

The purchase will provide for additional data cabling services described above to support the approved CIP projects in the upcoming twelve month period. The term of the agreement would be extended to December 31, 2009.

DISCUSSION

The City has an agreement, #157-07 with Pacific Coast Cabling, Inc. for as needed services related to the City's Capital Improvements Projects (CIP). The services include a variety of cabling tasks such as installation, termination and testing of multi-node fiber; installation, termination and testing of copper feeder(s); and any additional cabling items requested by City. Relocation of staff to the temporary modular staff offices is an example of the application of these services.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funds were budgeted and are available in the FY 08-09 Capital Improvement Budget for this purpose.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AND PACIFIC COAST CABLING, INC. D.B.A. PCC NETWORK SOLUTIONS FOR COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES RELATED TO CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

This Amendment No. 1 is to the Agreement between the City of Beverly Hills (hereinafter called "CITY"), and Pacific Coast Cabling, Inc. d.b.a. PCC Network Solutions Kastner, Inc., (hereinafter called "VENDOR") dated May 15, 2007 and identified as Contract No. 157-07.

RECITALS

A. CITY entered into a written agreement with VENDOR dated May 15, 2007 for communications infrastructure services related to CITY's capital improvement projects.

B. CITY desires VENDOR to perform additional services in connection with capital improvement projects including the Police Facility remodel, the Emergency Operations Center expansion, and related relocation of staff offices.

C. CITY desires to amend the Termination Date of the Agreement, increase the scope of services and increase the Consideration for the additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

Section 1. The Termination Date shall be amended as set forth above.

Section 2. The Consideration shall be amended as set forth above.

Section 3. Exhibit A, "Scope of Work", shall be amended as attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. Except as specifically amended by this Amendment No. 1, the Agreement dated May 15, 2007 shall remain in full force and effect.



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EXHIBIT A

Scope of Work

VENDOR shall provide, to the satisfaction of CITY, cabling services on an as-needed basis to meet CITY's ongoing cabling needs including the Police Facility remodel, the Emergency Operations Center expansion, and related relocation of staff offices ("the Services"). The Services shall include all necessary parts and labor associated with installation, termination and testing of new 6 strand 62.5 multi mode fiber installation, termination and testing of new 100 pair copper feeder(s), and any additional cabling items as requested by CITY. VENDOR shall label all completed work and shall provide CITY with documentation noting successful testing of installed cable, and final as-built specifications to CITY.

For each requested engagement, VENDOR shall submit a written scope of work which shall include a breakdown of all costs and warranties to CITY's authorized representative for written approval, acceptance and authorization to proceed.

VENDOR shall provide a full one year warranty on all products and workmanship. All work shall be performed with State and local laws.
