AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES &  
CHARGES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010

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### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt the resolution amending the fees and charges in Sections 1 through 7 and 9 through 11 of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges for Fiscal Year 2009/2010. Excluded are the Parking Citations, Taxes, and Utility Rates (Sections 8, 12, and 13, respectively).

### INTRODUCTION

With the passage of Proposition 4 that became Article XIII B of the State Constitution, fee services cannot exceed the "costs reasonable borne" by the City in delivery of such services. In compliance with this State law, the City periodically performs a full cost study to confirm current costs of services and to recommend cost recovery levels for these fee-based programs, the last cost study being performed in 2007 with the Revenue & Cost Specialists, LLC consulting group.

In accordance with Section 3-1.1001 of the Beverly Hills Municipal code and Ordinance No. 79-0-1749, City fees and charges are adjusted annually, based upon the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the preceding twelve months, with the exception of Taxes in Section 12, which are governed by the City's Municipal Code, and Utility Rates set forth in Section 13, which are adopted by separate ordinance. Additionally, all parking citation fees, Section 8 (Parking

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Citations) were recently increased by action of the City Council, and are not being considered at this time. The Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges adjustments are set by Council resolution for the new fees and rates discussed herein and contained in Exhibit "A."

Adjustments to the Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges for Fiscal Year 2009/2010 are to reflect increases based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase of 1.1% to the City's fees and charges. In some cases, the fees may be adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more equitable distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI.

Except as otherwise indicated, all non-development fees are scheduled to become effective July 1, 2009. Fees for development applications, per State law, become effective 60 days after adoption of the adjusted fee schedule, July 13, 2009.

## **DISCUSSION**

### **Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments**

Exhibit "A," which includes Sections 1 through 7 and 9 through 11 of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges for Fiscal Year 2009/2010, was increased by 1.1%, except as noted below. This percentage represents the difference between the CPI of November 2007 and November 2008. The fees that were not adjusted in line with the CPI will be further discussed. The following sections of the Schedule of Taxes, Fees & Charges are contained in Exhibit A:

- Section 1- Ambulance and Alarm Fees
- Section 2 – Appeals & Hearings
- Section 3 – Business Permits
- Section 4 – Copies, Reports, etc.
- Section 5 – Facilities Use Fees
- Section 6 – Inspections, Permits & Reviews
- Section 7 – Library Services
- Section 8 – Parking Citations (not being considered at this time)
- Section 9 – Parking Rates (parking facility rates will continue at the current rates)
- Section 10 – Recreation Fees & Animal Licenses
- Section 11 – Special Events and Filming
- Section 12 – Taxes (not being considered at this time)
- Section 13 – Utility Rates (not being considered at this time)

For ease of collection, fees have been rounded to the nearest dime (\$0.10), with the exception of the following:

- 1) Fees charged by Community Services, which were rounded upward to the nearest dollar in response to the staff and the public's request that the City's fees be rounded off when and where it is possible.
- 2) Fees that are less than \$1.00.

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Section 12 (Taxes) and Section 13 (Utility Rates), of the Comprehensive Schedule are reviewed and acted upon separately. Additionally, all parking citation fees, Section 8 (Parking Citations) were recently increased by action of the City Council, and are not being considered at this time and the parking facility rates will continue at the current rates.

### **FEES INCREASED ABOVE CPI**

As stated above, some fees may be adjusted to reflect a change in service level, more equitable distribution of costs, or to obtain full-cost recovery, rather than by the CPI. The fees that are being increased above the CPI are outlined below.

The City's municipal code governs the use of public facilities and sets the framework for the rental of public facilities. The City's Municipal Code, Section 8-1-6 permits the use of recreational facilities for rental for exclusive use, when such facilities are not in use for City functions.

#### **Room Rentals**

Certain fees for room rentals, such as use of the City's Municipal Gallery, have been raised above the CPI and more in line with the prevailing rates for room rentals in the area. The Municipal Gallery was previously listed along with the Library Auditorium. The Municipal Gallery fee is now listed separately and the rate adjusted to be commensurate with other historical/unique meeting locations (City of Fullerton's Muckenthaler Cultural Center; Descanso Gardens "Van de Kamp Hall," La Canada, etc.) Along with room rental fees, a kitchen use security deposit has been added to be consistent with fees charged in other locations.

#### **Greystone**

A maintenance fee was added to Greystone weddings and special events to cover the cost of cleaning the space after the event. Wedding and Special Event fees at Greystone have been increased by 40% to keep them in line with other similar and/or historical facilities.

#### **Trolley Fares and Guided Trolley Tours**

Trolley fares are recommended for increase in order to achieve cost-recovery. Fares for the trolley service have not been raised since 1997. Additionally, the Beverly Hills Convention and Visitors' Bureau is supportive of the fare increase. A modest reduction for Guided Trolley Tour fees are recommended for Beverly Hills resident use.

#### **Park Grounds (Other than Athletic Fields)**

Fees for use of park grounds and athletic fields, for non-recurring, non-consecutive use by patrons, not part of organized sports groups and leagues have increased above CPI in that they have been rounded upward to the nearest dollar. A new hourly fee for Park Ranger staff time has been added in conjunction with these fees for events staffed by City Park Rangers.

#### **In-Lieu Parking**

The fee for In-Lieu Parking Seismic Upgrade Incentive is a fee that is increased by the Construction Cost Index (CCI), which is 5.4% from July 2007 to July 2008.

## **NEW FEES**

### **Beverly Canon Gardens**

Weddings and Special Events fees have been added for the new Beverly Canon Gardens. The recommended fees for the new Beverly Canon Gardens are considerably higher than those set for weddings and events at Greystone Mansion.

### **Athletic Fields and Facilities**

New fees for use of athletic fields used by organized sports leagues such as youth sport organizations, the primary users of the fields and facilities, are being proposed to offset the increasing costs associated with the upkeep and maintenance of City athletic fields and facilities. A detailed analysis and staff recommendation have been provided to the Council at the City Council Study Session of May 13, 2009.

### **Police Jail Facility Fee**

The Police Department recommends the establishment of a “pay to stay” fee for the City’s jail facility. This fee will allow the City to develop a program where inmates, who have been court-ordered to serve time, would pay a fee to serve their time in the City’s jail instead of a county jail facility.

### **Library Fees**

The Library has found it expedient to provide some basic supplies to customers while they are using our public computers, such as floppy disks, USB drives, and earphones, and each at cost-recovery rates. The Library is also recommending use fees for photographs for commercial purposes; these fees are paid in addition to actual cost of prints and digital images. The Library recommends continuing these services and setting the costs at rates for the actual cost to the library to provide services and to purchase materials.

### **Cell Site Pole Rent**

A new fee is being recommended for cell site pole rent, which has not been charged previously. This fee is listed under the Inspections, Permits & Reviews section of the Fee Schedule under the Engineering subsection.

### **Water Efficient Landscape Permit Fee**

The fee for providing Water Efficient Landscape Permits is being increased from \$86.80 to \$251 per hour. In the past this fee did not provide for full cost-recovery of the staff time required in the permitting process. This new fee will recover these costs.

### **Fire Inspection Fees**

The Fire Department currently conducts Business Office and Retail Occupancy Inspections, Multifamily Residential Occupancy (3 or more units), and Brush Clearance Inspections for compliance with the California Fire Code and the Beverly Hills Municipal code. These inspections have previously been conducted free-of-charge for the initial inspection and the first

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re-inspection. The Fire Department recommends these service fees be raised to achieve full cost recovery.

### **Special Events Personnel Charges**

Rates for Sworn Police personnel covering special events will increase from \$96.00 per hour, for a minimum of four hours, to \$105.00 per hour, for a minimum of four hours. This increase does not fully recover the costs for providing these services. Staff recommends not increasing the fee any further at this time in order to allow the City to continue to attract revenue-generating special events and business to the city.

### **Planning Fees**

There are a number of planning fees that are being added to the schedule that may be new fees or fees that have currently existed in the building and safety division but is work that is performed in the planning department. Another example is the

For example, covenants are processed through the building and safety division. There are also covenants that are processed by the Planning staff and therefore a comparable fee needs to be assessed and assigned to Planning to obtain cost recovery. Another example is the plan check review fee. Planning staff reviews all development projects for compliance with Title 10 (Zoning Ordinance) during plan check review prior to issuance of a building permit. Historically, this review was performed by Plan Review Engineers in the Building & Safety division. A planning fee was added to reflect this work.

### **Refund of Planning Fees**

There is no current policy for processing refunds of partially completed applications. The percentage breakdown below reflects the amount of time a planner would have typically spent at different stages of the application review process and is consistent with neighboring communities: Projects not determined complete for filing may receive an 85% refund. Projects determined complete for filing, but no public notice or staff report published may receive a 70% refund. Projects that have been noticed or staff reports prepared may receive a 25% refund. This is now set forth in the fee schedule.

### **PLANNING FEES TO BE MODIFIED**

There are a number of planning fees that have been increased to better obtain cost recovery on certain planning activity. These fees are in the area of the environmental assessment and environmental review of projects such as environmental assessment for categorical exemptions, negative declaration, and environmental impact reports.

### **ENGINEERING FEES TO BE MODIFIED**

Certain engineering fees are also being adjusted. Fees for Final Parcel Map and Final Tract Maps are being reduced to be consistent with the fees that are being passed through to us from our outside reviewer, RKA. The lot line adjustment fee, however, is being increased to be consistent

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with the fees that are being passed through to us from our outside reviewer RKA. This ensures full cost-recovery in these areas.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

In the General Fund, it is estimated that the total adjustments to the comprehensive Schedule of Taxes, Fees, & Charges will achieve approximately \$1,715,761 in additional cost recovery based on the CPI and revenue analysis.

**RESOLUTION NO. 09-R \_\_\_\_\_**

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE  
SCHEDULE OF TAXES, FEES & CHARGES FOR THE  
FISCAL YEAR 2009/2010**

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does resolve as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 3-1.1001 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code and Ordinance No. 79-0-1749, there are hereby established, amended, fixed and modified, effective July 1, 2009 (except as otherwise set forth herein) taxes, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, exactions, and required payments for Municipal services, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2009/10 Rate." Fees for development are hereby established, amended, fixed and modified effective July 13, 2009, as set forth in Exhibit "A" under the column "2009/10 Rate." Except for those fees that are not being modified, said designations shall supersede and prevail over any prior provisions concerning the same subjects in any former resolution, motion or other action of this council, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 79-0-1749 shall also prevail over any inconsistent provisions of the Municipal Code. In addition, all fees whether or not modified herein, shall continue and remain in effect unless and until modified by resolution, motion or other action of this council.

Section 2. Notwithstanding Section 1, the City Council is taking action only on those taxes, fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, extractions, and required payments for Municipal services, inspections, enforcement activities or for other indicated purposes, and taxes which have been modified as set forth in Exhibit A. The remaining taxes, fees, permit fees, City service charges, and other fees, charges, extractions, and required

payments for Municipal services listed in Exhibit A that have not been modified are hereby restated solely for informational purposes.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of this City.
