RECOMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council move to appropriate \$9,200 for the purchase of ballistic vests as follows:

INTRODUCTION

On June 16, 2009, the City Council approved a resolution appointing the City Manager or his designee as agent of the City to apply for and accept an award for the FY2009 Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP). On October 6, 2009, the City received notice from the Bureau of Justice Assistance that the City was awarded \$4,597.00 for the FY2009 BVP.

DISCUSSION


In 2003 and in 2008, the Police Department participated in the BVP to replace ballistic vests which had exceeded their life expectancy. The department anticipates the need to purchase 17 vests for police officers between April 1, 2009 and September 30, 2011. The FY 2009 BVP grant will reimburse the City for 50% of the costs associated with purchasing these vests.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost for purchasing 17 ballistic vests is approximately \$9,193.00. An appropriation from the General Fund in the amount of \$9,200.00 is needed to fund the purchases of these vests. The BVP will reimburse the City for 50% of the costs associated with these purchases, up to a maximum of \$4,597.00.
