ORDINANCE NO. 10-O-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS  
RELATING TO TERMS OF COMMISSIONERS AND  
AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL  
CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY  
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph A of Section 2-2-105 of Article 1 of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"A. Appointments to a commission shall be for an initial term of two (2) years. At the discretion of the city council, commissioners may be reappointed to a second term. Appointments to a second term may be for up to four (4) years. The city council may appoint any commission member or members to terms shorter or longer than those set forth in this subsection if the city council determines that a shorter or longer term or terms is in the best interest of the commission or is appropriate to stagger the terms of appointees so that the terms of all or a majority of members do not expire concurrently or inappropriately close in time."

Section 2. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage, in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code; shall attest and certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and the City Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.
