INTRODUCTION

This report asks the City Council to accept and appropriate funds donated to the Library by the Friends of the Beverly Hills Public Library and Betty Harris in support of the Senior Library at the Roxbury Community Center, delivery of materials to homebound seniors and pick up materials that are donated to the Library.

DISCUSSION

The Friends of the Beverly Hills Public Library and Betty Harris have generously donated \$24,070 to the Beverly Hills Public Library. \$20,070 will be going to support the delivery of materials to homebound seniors as well as the pickup of materials that are to be donated to the Library. The additional \$4000 was donated by Betty Harris, long time Friends board member and past President of the Friends of the Library. Ms. Harris' donation is intended to support the collection of large type books at the Senior Library at Roxbury Community Center.


The funding for these services were eliminated in fiscal year 09-10 due to the difficult budget downturn. Thankfully the Friends of the Library have chosen to support these valuable services for the past two years.

FISCAL IMPACT


The donations totaling \$24,070 have no fiscal impact on the City's General Fund obligation. These funds will be used for the delivery of materials to homebound seniors, the pickup of materials that are to be donated to the Library, and for materials for the Roxbury Senior Library.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-R-

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ACCEPTING A DONATION FROM THE FRIENDS OF THE BEVERLY HILLS PUBLIC LIBRARY FOR LIBRARY OPERATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,070 AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. Friends of the Beverly Hills Public Library has offered the City a donation of \$24,070 toward City Public Library (“Library”) operations.

Section 2. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 37354 and 37355, the City may accept such gift and may put such gift to such uses as the City Council prescribes.

Section 3. The City Council hereby accepts the donation for Library operations including delivery of materials to homebound seniors, pick up of materials being donated to the Library and support of large-type books at the Senior Library at Roxbury Community Center.

Section 4. Appropriation of funds in the amount of \$24,070 is authorized as follows:

Section 5. The City hereby appoints the City Manager or his designee as agent of the City of Beverly Hills to accept the donated funding and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, purchase orders and payment requests, which may be necessary for Library operations.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.


