

RESOLUTION NO. 11-R-

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ON MARCH 8, 2011, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Beverly Hills, California, on Tuesday, March 8, 2011, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that candidates were nominated to fill the vacancy or vacancies as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 92-R-8522, adopted by the City Council on March 3, 1992, the City Clerk canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except vote-by-mail voter ballots and provisional ballots were 2,401.

The whole number of vote-by-mail and provisional ballots cast in the City was 3,331, making a total of 5,732 ballots cast in the City.

SECTION 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

NANCY H. KRASNE

LILI BOSSE

JULIAN A. GOLD

SECTION 3. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the office of member of the City Council for which the persons were candidates were as listed in Exhibit A attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that: LILI BOSSE was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years and JULIAN A. GOLD was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

SECTION 5. There were submitted to the qualified voters of said City the following measures, to wit:

MEASURE 2P:

Shall an ordinance be adopted to require the City Council to provide free parking for two hours at particular City-owned parking facilities and limit the amount of monthly parking at those facilities?

MEASURE 3P:

Shall an ordinance be adopted to provide Beverly Hills residents with free parking for three hours daily and a discount of 50% from evening flat rates at particular City-owned parking facilities?

MEASURE O:

Shall an ordinance that increases the oil extraction tax imposed on oil companies and establishes a natural gas extraction tax on oil and gas companies for deposit into the General Fund to support general fund services including police, fire, paramedics, library, administrative support services, and street and park maintenance, and that makes a change to the definition of gross receipts set forth in the Beverly Hills Municipal Code, be adopted?

Section 6. The votes cast in the precincts established for said election upon said measures and for and against said measures, the vote-by-mail votes cast for and against said measures, and the total votes cast at said election for and against said measures and upon said measures are as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" constituting the certification of the Canvass of Votes by the City Clerk of the City of Beverly Hills, dated March 14, 2011.

SECTION 7. The votes of a majority of all the voters voting at said election upon Measure 2P were cast in favor of the adoption of Measure 2P, and pursuant to Elections Code Section 15400, Measure 2P is hereby declared to be adopted. The votes of a majority of all the voters voting at said election upon Measure 3P were cast in opposition to the adoption of Measure 3P, and pursuant to Elections Code Section 15400, Measure 3P is hereby declared to be not adopted. The votes of a majority of all the voters voting

at said election upon Measure O were cast in opposition to the adoption of Measure O, and pursuant to Elections Code Section 15400, Measure O is hereby declared to be not adopted.

SECTION 8. The City Clerk shall enter in the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the results of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) for what office each person was voted for; (4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; and (5) the total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 9. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; the City Clerk or a duly authorized person shall administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 10. The City Clerk of this City shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the Book of Resolutions of this City, which entry shall constitute the City Clerk's statement of the results of the election.


