RECOMMENDATION

City Council is requested to accept the City of Beverly Hills' allocation of the 2009 and 2010 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) in the amount of \$5,032.50 and \$4,822.25, respectively.

INTRODUCTION

Emergency Management Performance Grants, EMPG, are used to support comprehensive emergency management at local levels and to encourage the improvement of mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities for all hazards and disasters. The City's allocation will be used to offset the City's Emergency Management Director's salary.

DISCUSSION

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) has approved grant funding for state and national homeland security efforts. This grant funding is provided to support comprehensive emergency management at local levels and to encourage the

improvement of mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities for all hazards and disasters.

The grant is managed and received by the County of Los Angeles Operational Area, Office of Emergency Management who then provides funding to the eight County Disaster Management Areas. The amount of funds provided is based on a per capita population formula. Area A, which is comprised of the Cities of Beverly Hills, Culver City, Santa Monica and West Hollywood, received their share of \$20,130 for 2009 and \$19,289 for 2010. The figure was then divided equally between the four cities. Each of the Area Cities billed a portion of their Emergency Manager's salaries to the grant. This grant has a 50% cost share which was matched by the same managers' salaries. The Beverly Hills allocation is \$5,032.50 for 2009 and \$4822.25 for 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT

These funds are provided by the County of Los Angeles and designated for Area A. This request is in accordance with terms of the grant and the Area A JPA, the by-laws and board's direction.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ACCEPTING THE CITY'S ALLOCATION OF THE 2009 AND 2010 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT ("EMPG") IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$5,032.50 AND \$4,822.25, RESPECTIVELY.

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. Emergency Management Performance Grants (EMPG) are used to support comprehensive emergency management at local levels and to encourage the improvement of mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery capabilities for all hazards and disasters. EMPG are managed by the County of Los Angeles Operational Area, Office of Emergency Management which then provides funding to the eight County Disaster Management Areas. Beverly Hills is part of County Disaster Management Area A which has been allocated funding for 2009 and 2010 in the amounts of \$20,130 and \$19,289, respectively.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the acceptance of the City's portion of the 2009 and 2010 EMPG totaling \$9,854.75.

Section 3. The check for the 2009 grant for \$5,032.50 and the check for the 2010 grant for \$4,822.25 will be deposited into Emergency Management Performance Grant account 4804101F027. This funding will be used to offset the City's Emergency Management Director's salary.

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.


