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### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting grant funding from the California Office of Traffic Safety and appropriating funds in the amount of \$140,000 for Police Department traffic enforcement operations as follows:

**INTRODUCTION**

The Police Department intends to maintain its sobriety enforcement operations during FY11/12 and conduct DUI and driver's license checkpoints, DUI saturation patrols, special enforcement operations, and warrant operations. Under this grant, the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS)—acting through the grant administration office of the School of Public Health at UC Berkeley—has agreed to reimburse the City for overtime, travel, and supplies expenses incurred for conducting authorized grant activities.

**DISCUSSION**

The City has undertaken an aggressive campaign of public education and traffic enforcement relating to the hazards of drinking and driving. Grant funding through OTS has supported sobriety and driver's licensing checkpoint operations. This funding will continue the Police Department's public safety efforts.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

An appropriation of \$140,000.00 is requested to fund Police traffic enforcement operations. The City will be reimbursed by OTS for authorized expenditures.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS APPLYING FOR THE FY11/12 SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE STATE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) administers the FY11/12 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) which is a grant program that reimburses law enforcement agencies for conducting sobriety enforcement and traffic safety programs.

Section 2. The City of Beverly Hills ("City") hereby appoints the City Manager or his designee to apply for and, if awarded, accept the FY11/12 STEP grant to conduct sobriety enforcement and traffic safety programs. Upon award to the City, the City Manager or his designee is also authorized to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for administration of the FY11/12 STEP grant.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.






