INTRODUCTION

This report is intended to inform the City Council that the City will be hosting the State Historical Resources Commission's quarterly meeting on August 3, 2012, in City Council Chambers from 9:00 a.m. until approximately noon. The Mayor will welcome the Commission at the beginning of the meeting and anyone who is interested is invited to attend the meeting.

DISCUSSION

The State Historical Resources Commission (SHRC) is a nine-member state review board, appointed by the Governor, with responsibilities for the identification, registration, and preservation of California's cultural heritage. The SHRC meets at least four times per year to give citizens an opportunity to participate in the public hearings. The meetings are held in different locations around the state and the Commission has elected to hold its August meeting in Beverly Hills, in part to acknowledge the City's recent adoption of a Historic Preservation Ordinance.

In accordance with State law, the primary responsibility of the SHRC is to review applications for listing historic and archaeological resources on the National Register of Historic Places, the California Register of Historical Resources, and the California Historical Landmarks and California Points of Historical Interest registration programs.

The official quarterly public meeting on August 3rd will be preceded by the Commission's workshop meeting on August 2, 2012, which will be held at Greystone Mansion from 10:00 a.m. until noon. That meeting will also be open to the public and generally includes no more than fifteen people.
