RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended by the City Council-Fine Arts Commission Liaison (Bosse/Brucker) and the Fine Art Commission that the term of Fine Art Commissioner Curt Shepard be extended through February 2013 to allow Mr. Shepard to work with the Commission to complete the revision of the Public Art Ordinance.

INTRODUCTION

Curt Shepard was appointed to the Fine Arts Commission in 2006, so without an extension, Commissioner Shepard would term off the Commission on November 15, 2012. The City Council-Fine Arts liaison and the Fine Arts Commission recommend that the City Council extend the term of Commissioner Curt Shepard through February 2013 to allow time to complete the revision of the Public Art Ordinance.

DISCUSSION

The Fine Art Commission is presently engaged in rewriting the Beverly Hills Public Art Ordinance, and it is expected that this revision will be complete at the beginning of 2013. Because he has been engaged in this revision process from the beginning and because he is a former Chair of the Commission, the Council liaison and Commission recommend that Mr. Shepard's term be extended through February of 2013 so he can contribute to the finalization of the ordinance revision.

Per City Council's direction, the Fine Art Commission has reduced its membership from 7 members to 6 members. With the departure of Commissioner Shepard, the Commission will be reduced to the target of 5 members.
