RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the purchase of patrol rifles and accessory package from Clyde Armory in the amount of \$87,361.60.

INTRODUCTION

There is a strong need for properly equipped first responding officers to be able to act swiftly to decisively mitigate any threat.

The importance of first responders to be adequately equipped is critical and waiting for SWAT to respond is not an option. The outcome of an incident may be dependent on

field officers being able to respond with sufficient firepower. Rifles give officers the ability to accurately engage suspects at significant distances and defeat body armor. The Colt AR-15 Weapon System is lightweight, easy to operate, has little recoil, and requires minimal training for officers to become proficient.

In general, rifles are currently only available to officers assigned to SWAT, Specialized Units and Field Training Officers. The Department possesses a limited number of rifles and does not have enough to equip all officers.


DISCUSSION

This purchase would equip every field officer with a patrol rifle giving all first responders the tools to be adequately equipped for any situation. To reiterate what was stated in the introduction; a critical incident could occur anywhere at any time. We have learned that time is of the essence when dealing with many of these types of incidents and waiting for equipment to arrive from other locations could jeopardize public safety and possibly cost lives.

There are two vendors that sell the rifle we are using. Of the two vendors, Clyde Armory is the only vendor who has rifles in stock and the rifle package built to Beverly Hills Police Department specifications. This package saves us time and money and provides the exact equipment we need without having to deal with multiple vendors.

FISCAL IMPACT

The costs associated with this purchase total \$87,361.60. These items would be purchased with asset forfeiture funds which the City Council appropriated on July 03, 2012. This base rifle has a life cycle potential of 20+ years depending on usage. There will be a replacement cost at some point. Due to the extended life cycle of this equipment it is likely they will be replaced with new technology. This would afford us the opportunity to utilize asset forfeiture money to replace the rifles with whatever new system is developed.
