1. Request by the Mayor to Provide In-Kind Services in Support of a Special Event Request at Greystone Park for the Beverly Hills Courier Mayor Mirisch has requested City Council review of the request by the Beverly Hills Courier for the City to provide in-kind services at Greystone Park to offset fees typically charged for a commercial photography session.

Deputy City Manager Cheryl Friedling introduced the request from Mayor Mirisch requesting a deferral of fees for the Beverly Hills Courier's use of Greystone Mansion for a photo shoot.

Marcia Hobbs, representing the Beverly Hills Courier, spoke briefly regarding their request.

Recreation Services Manager Brad Meyerowitz responded to questions regarding the fees associated with commercial photo shoots at City parks and the waiver of fees.


Assistant City Attorney Lolly Enriquez answered questions from Councilmember Gold regarding gifts of public funds and whether or not this could be considered a gift of public funds.
