Subject: Public Works Commission Interview Panel Report

INTRODUCTION

The Public Works Commission Interview Panel composed of Mayor John A. Mirisch, Councilmember Nancy Krasne, Public Works Commission Chair Barry D. Pressman, MD, and Public Works Commission Vice Chair Ron Shalowitz met on Monday, September 23, 2013. The panel received ten applications, and interviewed nine candidates for two positions on the Public Works Commission. One candidate's application was withdrawn on September 18, 2013.

DISCUSSION

After discussion and careful review, it was the consensus of the Panel to recommend Sandra Aronberg, MD, and Jeff Wolfe for appointment to fill the two positions.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Works Commission Interview Panel recommends that the City Council appoint Sandra Aronberg, MD, and Jeff Wolfe to the Public Works Commission. With the concurrence of the Council, a formal report will be prepared for adoption at the next City Council meeting.

In addition, the Panel requests that the remaining candidates be thanked and advised that they each gave thoughtful and compelling answers to the questions posed by the Panel. The City is fortunate to have such an exceptional applicant pool and the applicants are encouraged to attend as many future Public Works Commission meetings as possible and reapply for future vacancies. In addition, those applicants who have not participated in Team Beverly Hills are urged to do so.
