INTRODUCTION

This report provides an update on Metro's public outreach for the Metro Purple Line Section 1 which includes the construction of the La Cienega Boulevard station.

DISCUSSION

Staff provided an update of Metro's construction plans for the Purple Line La Cienega station at the September 10, 2013 City Council Study Session and a permit for Geotechnical Exploration at the Formal Meeting. Per City Council direction, staff is preparing a draft agreement between the City and Metro to coordinate construction activities for the La Cienega station. Over the next several months, staff anticipates two major decision points for the La Cienega Station construction: 1) potential agreement between the City and Metro to coordinate construction activities and 2) construction hours (e.g., night-time vs. day-time) of the utility relocations for the La Cienega station

Metro has initiated a public outreach program for the Purple Line Section 1 construction with residential and business representatives surrounding the three Section 1 stations. The initial meeting was held in June 2013 and the next meeting will be on October 29, 2013 at 5:30 pm at the Peterson Museum. The meeting is open to the general public. Currently, there are 14 individuals representing residents, businesses and institutions in the La Cienega Station vicinity (attached). Metro will accept proposals for additional members. Please advise Aaron Kunz if you wish to propose additional members to Metro by October 22, 2013. There are 18 individuals representing the area around the Fairfax station and 12 around the La Brea station.
