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### RECOMMENDATION

At the City Council Study Session of October 15, 2013, Council directed that staff bring forward the appointment of Sandra Aronberg, MD to fill the first position and Jeff Wolfe to fill the second position on the Public Works Commission.

Each Commissioner will be eligible for reappointment per Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 2-2-105.

### INTRODUCTION

The agenda report transmits a formal request to appoint Sandra Aronberg, MD and Jeff Wolfe to fill the first and second available positions on the Public Works Commission, respectively.

### DISCUSSION

The Public Works Commission Interview Panel report was presented to the City Council at the Study Session of October 15, 2013. At that time the City Council directed that staff return with this item formally appointing Sandra Aronberg, MD and Jeff Wolfe to the Public Works Commission. This action will formally approve these appointments presented to the City Council at the Study Session.

The City Council has also scheduled for discussion at the November 19, 2013 Study Session the potential expansion of the Public Works Commission to seven members and the extension of the terms of two existing Commissioners whose terms have already expired.

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
If Dr. Aronberg and Mr. Wolfe are appointed on November 5th, then the expired terms of the sitting Commissioners will end and they will be replaced by Dr. Aronberg and Mr. Wolfe. Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 2-2-105, subsection C provides that "a member may serve beyond expiration of that member's term until such time as a successor is appointed."

If the City Council wishes to continue the terms of the sitting Commissioners whose terms have expired, then the City Council will need to delay the effective date of the appointment of the new Commissioners.

Alternatively, if the City Council wishes to continue with the direction given to staff on October 15<sup>th</sup>, the City Council may decide to appoint new Commissioners on November 5<sup>th</sup> and if the City Council later decides to expand the Public Works Commission and wishes to reappoint the current Commissioners, the City Council could make that reappointment at the time that it expands the membership of the Commission.
