### **INTRODUCTION**

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) is a regional association representing the interests of six Southern California counties, 191 member cities and over 18 million residents. SCAG engages in a variety of planning and policy initiatives.

The SCAG General Assembly will be conducted May 1-2, 2014 in Indian Wells, California. During the General Assembly, each member city will be represented by a delegate (or alternate) who will participate on issues of common interest to the SCAG members.

### **DISCUSSION**
