### **DISCUSSION**


The Public Safety Program is a community program that will feature representatives from the Police and Fire Departments. The panel will include Mayor Lili Bosse, Fire and Police Department representatives, and Thomas White will serve as the moderator. The program will highlight the City's public safety services and programs, provide updates regarding the Departments' policies, and include a question and answer period. The program will take place in the Municipal Gallery and will be free and open to the general public.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Since the City is a co-sponsor of the program that is free to the general public, and features City officials as well as City staff as keynote speakers, the rental fees will not be required, and the nominal personnel costs (\$228) will be covered by the City.
