RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Fehr & Peers, a change order of \$50,000 to the current purchase order of \$50,000 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000.

INTRODUCTION

On March 1, 2014, the City entered into an agreement with Fehr & Peers Transportation Consultants with a consideration amount of \$50,000 for as-needed traffic consulting services. The primary purpose of that agreement was to address traffic issues in the Trousdale area. Additional services needed for that area and other City projects have been and are currently required since then. An amendment to this agreement is recommended to allow the consultant to continue to perform studies and analysis of traffic engineering, operations, planning, parking and design services for ongoing projects throughout the City.

DISCUSSION

Since the late 1990's, the City has had an agreement with a transportation engineering/planning consultant firm for additional expertise. Recent projects performed by Fehr & Peers include development review Metro Subway traffic control plans, Trousdale Estates traffic management, preparing a study of the Olympic/Beverly/Beverwil intersection and supporting development of the City's first bicycle routes. Upcoming projects include identifying appropriate locations for a future bicycle sharing program.

FISCAL IMPACT

Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Fehr & Peers Transportation Consultants will increase the agreement and purchase order amount by \$50,000 for a not-to-exceed total amount of \$100,000. Funds are available from the general fund and capital improvement program fund balance.




