RECOMMENDATION

The Traffic & Parking Commission recommends that the City Council approve a resolution of the Council of the City of Beverly Hills modifying Preferential Parking Permit Zone "AJ" on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil and Whitworth Drives from "1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, Permit 'AJ' Exempt" to add an evening regulation as follows:

"1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and
No Parking Any Other Time, Permit 'AJ' Exempt"

INTRODUCTION

The Traffic & Parking Commission reviewed a resident-initiated request to modify the existing 1-hour daytime permit regulation on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive at the February 5, 2015 meeting. The Commission unanimously voted 4-0 in support of staff's recommendation.

Chair Friedman, Vice Chair Manaster and Commissioners Licht and Seidel supported the petition based on the identical permit parking zone regulation on the adjacent 9400 block of Whitworth Drive and the lack of opposition at the meeting.

DISCUSSION

Background information is provided in the February 5, 2015 Traffic & Parking Commission staff report.

The high occupancy on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive is primarily composed of non-residents who park their vehicles for long durations after 6 p.m. These vehicles are concentrated on the southern end of the block, closest to the restaurants and hotels on Pico Boulevard in Los Angeles where a "No Parking" evening permit regulation is enforced in the adjacent residential blocks. Based on high resident support of the petition, commuter vehicles regularly interfering with available public parking adjacent to residential property, the observation of uniformed employees, and the restricted evening permit regulation in Los Angeles, the Traffic & Parking Commission supported adding a "No Parking" evening regulation to match the 9400 Whitworth Drive regulation established in December 2013.

Two residents from the 400 block of Smithwood Drive spoke at the February Traffic & Parking Commission meeting in support of a "No Parking Any Other Time" evening regulation.

A total of two letters were received from residents of the 400 block of Smithwood Drive: one supporting the petition request and one opposed to any changes to the current 1-hour daytime parking regulation.

Public Notices advising of City Council review at the February 17, 2015 formal meeting were mailed February 6, 2015 to the same mailing list used for the Traffic & Parking Commission.

FISCAL IMPACT

The cost of modifying parking signs would be nominal and installed by City staff.

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS MODIFYING PREFERENTIAL PARKING
PERMIT ZONE “AJ” ON THE 400 BLOCK OF SMITHWOOD
DRIVE BETWEEN BEVERWIL AND WHITWORTH DRIVES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 7-3-206(d), a qualifying petition to modify a Preferential Parking Permit Zone on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive was filed;

WHEREAS, the petition sought to modify a Preferential Parking Permit zone on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive;

WHEREAS, there is an existing permit parking regulation of “1-hour parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, Permit ‘AJ’ Exempt” on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive;

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2015, the Traffic & Parking Commission investigated the need to modify a Preferential Parking Permit Zone on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive;

WHEREAS, the Traffic & Parking Commission unanimously recommended modifying Preferential Parking Permit Zone “AJ” to a regulation of “1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and No Parking Any Other Time, Permit ‘AJ’ Exempt” on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Planning has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that the project is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act and has issued a Categorical Exemption;

NOW AND THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. Based upon the evidence and testimony presented to the City Council, including the information set forth in the Agenda Report, the findings required by BHMC Section 7-3-206(d) to justify modifying Preferential Parking Permit Zone “AJ” on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive can be made.

Section 2. The Council finds that the following designated preferential permit zone is required due to commuter vehicles regularly interfering with available public parking adjacent to residential property zone; or that such vehicles are the cause of unreasonable noise and pollution in the residential environment; or that there is no reasonable alternative which is feasible or practical to reduce the identified street parking problem to acceptable levels.

Section 3. The City Council hereby approves modifying Preferential Parking Permit Zone “AJ” on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive, subject to the provisions of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 7-3-206(d), with a regulation of:

“1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and
No Parking Any Other Time, Permit ‘AJ’ Exempt”

Section 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.

This report outlines a resident-initiated petition to modify the Preferential Parking Permit Zone on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive between Beverwil Drive and Whitworth Drive from “1-Hour Parking, 8am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday, Permit AJ Exempt” to include an evening permit regulation. Staff recommends modifying the current regulation as follows:

**“1-Hour Parking, 8am to 6pm, Monday-Saturday, and
No Parking Any Other Time, Permit AJ Exempt”**

INTRODUCTION

Smithwood Drive runs north/south between Beverwil and Whitworth Drives and has a “1 Hour Parking, 8 am to 6 pm Monday through Saturday, Permit AJ Exempt” regulation. This zone was established in 1996 based on a qualifying residential petition to address parking displacement generated by Los Angeles businesses and hotels located on Pico Boulevard in Los Angeles.

The streets south of the Beverly Hills city limits (in the City of Los Angeles) have day and evening permit restrictions. Smithwood Drive to the south of Whitworth Drive has a “1-hour Parking, 8am-6pm, Monday through Saturday, and No Parking All Other Times, District 15 Exempt” permit regulation and a “2-Hour Parking, 8am-6pm, Monday through Saturday, and No Parking All Other Times, District 25 Exempt” regulation on Edris Drive on the west fork south of Smithwood Drive.

DISCUSSION

Staff received a qualifying petition in December 2014 signed by 19 of the 28 (68%) single and multiple-family dwellings facing Smithwood requesting a “1-hour parking, 8 am to 6 pm, Monday through Saturday and No Parking Any Other time” regulation that mirrors the adjacent permit regulation on the 9400 block of Whitworth Drive. The letter accompanying the petition noted employee and commuter parking generated by hotel and commercial businesses located in the Los Angeles jurisdiction.

Staff conducted parking occupancy counts on Thursday, January 8, 2015 and Saturday, January 17, 2015 from 6pm to midnight. There are approximately 38 on-street parking spaces on the 400 block of Smithwood Drive within the Beverly Hills city limits.

At 8pm, parking occupancy peaked at 68% (26 of 38 spaces), with 58% (22 of 26) occupancy by non-residents vehicles. The non-resident vehicles were concentrated on the southern end of the block, closest to the Beverly Hills city limits and Los Angeles restaurants and hotels. Additionally, 15 of the 25 commuter vehicles observed were parked for five to seven hours during the 7-hour study period. Furthermore, during the Saturday parking occupancy survey conducted by Parking Enforcement, the parking officer observed a hotel/restaurant employee in uniform returning to his car at the south end of 400 Smithwood drive, leaving at midnight.

Staff supports the resident-initiated petition based on the 68% support of the petition, high percentage of non-resident parking duration, the existing permit restrictions in the Los Angeles jurisdiction, and residents' compromised lifestyle as a result of commuter parking in front of their homes. Staff's recommendation will mirror the existing restrictions established on the adjacent 9400 block of Whitworth Drive in December of 2013, stemming from the noise disturbances and displaced resident parking due to Los Angeles activity.

Public Notices advising of Traffic & Parking Commission's review of this request at its February 5, 2015 meeting were mailed on January 23, 2015 to Beverly Hills residents on the 400 block of Beverwil Drive, 400 block of Beverly Drive, 400 block of Smithwood Drive and 9400 block of Whitworth Drive.

One correspondence was received by close of business Wednesday, January 28th in support of the petition request.






We are having a problem on our street with vehicles not belonging to any of our residences, completely filling all curbside parking on our street after 6 pm. Presumably, this is from Hotel employees and retail employees working up the street at Pico and Smithwood, and Pico and Edris. Possibly, also the Hotel at Pico and Beverly Drive.

Currently, our restricted parking is 1 hour 8am to 6pm. We would like to petition to have our restricted parking extended to include hours after 6pm, seven days a week. Currently it runs only until 6pm, and is unrestricted thereafter.

We would suggest the City mirror the restrictions recently placed on Whitworth Drive, which simply read, 1 hour parking 8am-6pm "NO PARKING ALL OTHER TIMES except by Permit AJ".

We have collected far more than the required 61% of residents on the street. -Closer to 97%.

**PREFERENTIAL PARKING PERMIT ZONE
PETITION REQUEST**



A *Preferential Parking Permit Zone* allows Beverly Hills residents to park a vehicle(s) on their block during restricted parking hours. Residents of a designated permit zone may purchase up to three (3) permits per household annually at an approximate cost of \$33.50 each, with *fees subject to change each fiscal year*. Permits are valid through September 30th and may be renewed annually.

Residents may register to receive a daytime exemption permit at no additional cost when occasional parking needs exceed what can be accommodated with three (3) preferential parking permits. Residents must purchase the three annual preferential parking permits to be eligible to receive a daytime exemption permit. Preferential parking permits do not exempt residents from the City's overnight parking restriction between 2:30AM and 5AM. [BHMC 7-3-301]
