INTRODUCTION

The City was approached by representatives from the Beverly Hills North Homeowners Association to hold a town hall meeting on Jan. 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chamber about the issues surrounding Parcels 12 & 13.

The City Council will receive a complete report on this issue at its January 5, 2016 formal meeting.

This staff report is provided for information only; unless directed otherwise, staff will work with the North Homeowners Association to coordinate the use of the City Council Chamber for the town hall meeting.

DISCUSSION

On Nov. 21 and 22, 2015 the owner of Parcels 12 & 13, just north of Civic Center Drive, cut down a number of trees, which generated public concern over the possible impact to the neighborhood from the tree removal.

The homeowners group wishes to bring the community together to discuss the various issues, and they have asked that the meeting be recorded and streamed live on the City's Cable TV channel and the website. The only City venues where live streaming is feasible are the Council Chamber and the adjacent Room A.

FISCAL IMPACT

The anticipated fiscal impact is \$276 in part-time Cable TV staff hours to record the event, in addition to an unknown number of regular staff hours.
