Subject: Fine Art Commission Interview Panel Report

INTRODUCTION

The Fine Art Commission Interview Panel composed of Councilmember Lili Bosse, Councilmember Nancy Krasne, Fine Art Commission Vice Chair Alan Kaye and Fine Art Commissioner Carolyn Hiller met on Thursday, February 4, 2016. The interview panel received four applications and interviewed three candidates for one position on the Fine Art Commission. The fourth applicant was recently appointed to another Commission.

DISCUSSION

After discussion and careful review, it is the unanimous recommendation of the Panel to appoint **Stephanie Vahn** to fill the position of Fine Art Commissioner Brenda Potter whose term will be ending on June 30, 2016.

Ms. Vahn must attend all Fine Art Commission meetings leading up to her appointment.

RECOMMENDATION

The Fine Art Commission Interview Panel recommends that the City Council appoint Stephanie Vahn to the Fine Art Commission. With the concurrence of the Council, a formal report will be prepared for adoption at the next regular City Council meeting.

In addition, the Panel requests that the remaining candidates be thanked and advised that they each gave thoughtful and compelling answers to the questions posed by the Panel. The City is fortunate to have such an exceptional applicant pool and the applicants are encouraged to attend as many future Fine Art Commission meetings as possible and reapply for future vacancies. In addition, those applicants who have not participated in Team Beverly Hills are urged to do so.
