The City Council Adjourned Regular Meeting was held in at The Academy of Motion Picture Arts & Sciences Samuel Goldwyn Theater at 6:00 pm.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

NATIONAL ANTHEM PERFORMED BY CITY CLERK BYRON POPE

Mayor Gold thanked City Clerk Pope for performing the National Anthem.

On behalf of the City Council and the community, Mayor Gold thanked the Academy of Motion Picture Sciences for the use of the Samuel Goldwyn Theater and lobby. He announced that no photographs may be taken inside the theater.

B. *MATTERS PRESENTED BY COUNCILMEMBERS*

1. CITY COUNCIL REORGANIZATION, INCLUDING ELECTION AND INSTALLATION OF MAYOR AND VICE MAYOR.

Mayor Gold spoke about the impending departure of Councilmember Brien from the Council. A video highlighting Councilmember Brien's accomplishments as Councilmember and Mayor was shown.

Mayor Gold invited Councilmember Brien to make his parting remarks. Councilmember Brien thanked the community, his colleagues, City staff, his family, and key supporters

who have stood by him through the years, and spoke about key challenges in the City and key points during his term as Councilmember.

Mayor Gold invited the Councilmembers to make their parting remarks to Councilmember Brien.

Mayor Gold presented Councilmember Brien with a Key to the City, a street sign bearing his name, and other gifts.

A video tribute reviewing Mayor Gold's year as Mayor was presented.

Vice Mayor Krasne gave her acceptance speech. She thanked her family and spoke about the programs that she will be working on during her term as Vice Mayor.

Mayor Gold introduced the Beverly Hills High School (BHHS) Marching Band which played the "BHHS Fight Song" and "Sing, Sing, Sing."

Mayor Gold invited Mr. Pete Peterson and Vince Mirisch who brought the Jewish Bible on stage. Mr. Peterson administered the oath of office as Mayor to Vice Mayor Mirisch.

Mayor Mirisch gave his acceptance speech. He thanked the BHHS Marching Band, his family, colleagues, and key supporters, and spoke about his "Beverly Hills, Our Home" program and other programs he will be undertaking during his term as Mayor.

Councilmember Gold presented a signed scroll to Mayor Mirisch.


