### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the City Council provide direction regarding naming opportunities for trees in the dog park.

### **INTRODUCTION**

At the April 5, 2016 City Council study session, City Council discussed various donor recognition opportunities for the dog park. This report transmits the recommendation by the Recreation and Parks Commission to accept donations for the dog park, and to allow donor plaques on the wall of the park for donations that exceed \$1,000.

Since that time, two generous donors, Ms. Tina Sinatra and an anonymous donor, have come forward to give \$25,000 each toward the trees inside the dog park. These two donors have requested the ability to place a small plaque at the base of two of the trees. The plaque would be placed either on a small pedestal, arm or a rock.


### **DISCUSSION**

Council is asked to give direction regarding the placement of small plaques at the base of the trees in the dog park for a \$25,000 or greater donation. Staff recommends that the details of the plaque (exact size, material, etc.) be vetted by the Recreation and Parks Commission in conjunction with their recommendations for the plaques for the donor wall at the dog park.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

There would not be a fiscal impact as a result of naming opportunities for the trees in the dog park. The donor recognition program would bring in donations to help with aspects of the new dog park.
