INTRODUCTION

In light of the recent media reports, this item allows for Council discussion concerning voter integrity and the upcoming November election.

DISCUSSION

Over the past few days, various media outlets have reported that opponents of the Beverly Hilton initiative measure have alleged that voter integrity has been compromised, specifically Beverly Hills voters registered illegally to post office boxes rather than to their home addresses.

The County of Los Angeles Election Division has been alerted to these alleged incidents and the City Clerk's Office has requested notice of any suspected irregular activities.

The Assistant City Clerk and the City Attorney will be available on Tuesday to answer any questions.

RECOMMENDATION

The City is working closely with the County of Los Angeles to monitor any election irregularities and will report any such activities to the City Attorney and the District Attorney's Office. The City Council will be updated of any further developments.
