RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting a donation from the Konheim family and appropriate funds in the amount of \$6,000 for purchase of three Police Patrol bicycles.

INTRODUCTION

It is requested that the City Council adopt a resolution accepting the donated funding from Caroline and David Konheim and appropriate \$6,000 to fund the purchase of this public safety equipment.

DISCUSSION

The Bicycle Unit of the Police Field Services Division, Patrol Bureau, is being revitalized to deal with quality of life issues impacting the Community, such as with the Homeless Outreach program. To immediately meet this task, the Police Department has trained approximately 20 additional officers in bicycle patrol techniques with in-house instructors. These officers will be collaterally deployed as necessary in teams. These additional bicycles will replace equipment that has had eight to ten years of service and will be used by the Patrol Bicycle officers.

FISCAL IMPACT

An appropriation of \$6,000 is requested to fund purchase of three police bicycles. The City has received a donation of \$6,000 from the Konheim family to offset this expenditure.

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section1. In July of 2007, the City received a donation from the Konheim family, in the name of Caroline and David Konheim, for the purchase of bicycles for the Police Patrol Bureau.

Section2. The donated funding is in the amount of \$6,000 and will be placed in the City General Fund.

Section 3. Appropriation of funds in the amount of \$6,000 is authorized as follows:






