Park Master Plan

The Park Master Plan concept was discussed and background information provided as to actions that led to this point. The community outreach process was discussed briefly. La Cienega Community Center was built in 1980 and the Park was renovated in 1990. After years of consistent wear and tear, the athletic fields are in need of renovation. The needed improvements at La Cienega Park were presented.

The Roxbury Park Master Plan was discussed. The resident's interest in preserving open green space was a strong consideration in developing the Master Plan. The Community Center was built in the late 1950's and has sustained several renovations. The last renovation was completed 17 years ago. Each recreational element of the Master Plan was described and the rationale for the proposed renovations discussed. It was noted that the parking structure that is identified in the Master Plan would accommodate a maximum of 169 vehicles. The exact number of parking spaces would be determined during the next phase of the process when a parking consultant is hired.
