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### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the City Council approve the supplemental agreement between the City of Los Angeles and the City of Beverly Hills for disbursement of the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) 2005. The supplement extends the contract to December 31, 2007.

### INTRODUCTION

On March 6, 2006 the City Council entered into a contract with the City of Los Angeles accepting \$265,345 of grant funding under the Federal 05 Urban Area Security Initiative Grant (USAI). This grant was used to pay for training costs for the Fire and Police Departments and for critical infrastructure protection and physical security enhancements to the City Hall and Police Department. The contract expired on December 31, 2006. The supplement extends the contract to the end of the grant period, December 31, 2007.

### DISCUSSION

The City of Beverly Hills has spent the grant funding and has received full reimbursement from the City of Los Angeles. The State granted all UASI cities a grant extension to December 31, 2007. This is a supplemental agreement because it was generated for execution after the end of the original grant period. It functions in the same way as an amendment. Therefore the City of Los Angeles is requesting the signed supplement so the grant can be closed.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
AND THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT to Contract No. C-109843 between the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting through the Mayor's Office, Homeland Security and Public Safety and the City of Beverly Hills ("Contractor") is entered into with reference to the following:

WHEREAS on or about October 1, 2004, the City and the Contractor entered into Contract No. C-109843 (hereinafter the "Original Agreement"), pursuant to the Urban Area Security Initiative Grant 2005 (UASI '05), whereby the City distributed UASI '05 Grant Funds, and the Contractor agreed to address the unique equipment, training, planning and exercise needs of the area, to assist it in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS Contract No. C-109843 expired on December 31, 2006 and the City and Contractor now agree to continue Contractor's service to December 31, 2007 by executing this Supplemental Agreement, as authorized by the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 14.8; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. Contract No. C-109843 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference. The terms and conditions of said Contract shall be the terms and conditions of this Supplemental Agreement, except as expressly modified herein.
2. Term: The term of this Supplemental Agreement shall be from December 31, 2006 to December 31, 2007.
3. Compensation: There is no change to Section 301, Payment of Grant Funds and Method of Payment.
4. Except as herein amended, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
5. This Supplemental Amendment is executed in two (2) duplicate originals, each of which is deemed to be an original. This Amendment includes three (3) pages which constitute the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
6. Ratification Clause: Due to the need for the Contractor's services to be provided continuously on an ongoing basis, Contractor may have provided

services prior to the execution of this Supplemental Agreement. To the extent that said services were performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Supplemental Agreement, those services are hereby ratified.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City of Los Angeles and the Contractor have caused this Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives.
