RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council find that the tract map is consistent with the General Plan and adopt the resolution approving the final map for Tract Map No. 062714.

INTRODUCTION

This report is a request for City Council to find that Tract Map No. 062714 located at 149-185 South Rodeo Drive is consistent with the General Plan. It also provides for City Council adoption of a resolution approving the final map for Tract Map No. 062714.

DISCUSSION

The applicant, Lyn and Laurie Konheim Trust has prepared the tract map to covert an existing nineteen unit apartment complex to residential condominium at the property located at 149-185 South Rodeo Drive.

At its meeting of May 25, 2005, the Planning Commission approved Tentative Tract Map No. 062714 and at its meeting of July 12, 2007, the Planning Commission approved a time extension for subject tentative tract map located at the property at 149-185 South Rodeo Drive. The applicant submitted a final tract map for approval by the City Council that is substantially the same as the approved tentative tract map.

In accordance with the Subdivision Map Act, the City Council must find that the final tract map is consistent with the objectives, policies, general land uses and program specified in the General Plan.

RESOLUTION NO. 07-R-_____

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEVERLY HILLS APPROVING THE FINAL MAP FOR
TRACT MAP NO. 062714 (149-185 SOUTH RODEO DRIVE)

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills hereby finds, orders, and resolves as follows:

Section 1. Tentative Tract Map No. 062714 was submitted for approval of a subdivision consisting of nineteen (19) residential condominium units at 149-185 South Rodeo Drive.

Section 2. The Planning Commission conditionally approved said Tentative Tract Map on May 25, 2005 and granted a one-year extension of the Tentative Map on July 12, 2007, thus the final map has been filed in a timely manner.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Beverly Hills finds as follows:

(a) The final map filed herein is in substantial compliance with the approved tentative tract map and complies with all of the requirements of the California Government Code and the City's subdivision ordinance.

(b) The applicant has performed all conditions required by the tentative tract map.

(c) For the reasons set forth in the resolution approving the tentative tract map, the site of the proposed subdivision is physically suitable for the type of development proposed and for the proposed density of development.

(d) For the reasons set forth in the resolution approving the tentative tract map, the design of the subdivision and proposed improvements will not cause substantial environmental damage or any health problems and will not conflict with any public easements.

(e) For the reasons set forth in the resolution approving the tentative tract map, the discharge of waste from the proposed subdivision into the existing sewer system will not result in a violation of existing requirements prescribed by the California Regional Water Quality Board.

(f) For the reasons set forth in the resolution approving the tentative tract map, the final map and the design and improvement of the proposed subdivision are consistent with the City's General Plan and the Open Space Element thereof.

Section 4. The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

(a) The final map for Tract Map No. 062714 is approved.

Section 5. The City Engineer is directed to record the Final Map.

Section 6. The approval of the Final Tract Map shall be construed as approval of only those matters expressly shown or stated in the map, and shall not be construed as an approval of any other matters submitted to or considered by the Planning Commission or the Council and not expressly shown or stated on the Final Tract Map or in this Resolution.

Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and shall cause this Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of this City.


