RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the resolution accepting a donation of \$17,600 from Project Angel Food and appropriate funds in the amount of \$17,600 for the purchase of police bicycles and related equipment.

Project Angel Food has presented a donation to the City to facilitate purchase of this public safety equipment.


DISCUSSION

The Bicycle Unit of the Police Field Services Division, Patrol Bureau, is being revitalized to deal with quality of life issues impacting the community, such as the Homeless Outreach program. To immediately meet this task, the Police Department has trained approximately 20 officers in bicycle patrol techniques with in-house instructors. These officers will be collaterally deployed, as necessary, in teams. Additional bicycles and related equipment need to be purchased to replace equipment that has had eight to ten years of service.



RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ACCEPTING A DONATION OF \$17,600 FROM PROJECT ANGEL FOOD FOR POLICE BICYCLE EQUIPMENT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR PURCHASE OF THIS EQUIPMENT

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City has received a donation from Project Angel Food to be used for the Police Department's Patrol Bureau Bicycle Unit.

Section 2. The donated funding is in the amount of \$17,600 and will be deposited to the City General Fund.

Section 3. Appropriation of funds in the amount of \$17,600 is authorized as follows:

Section 4. The City hereby appoints the City Manager or his designee as agent of the City of Beverly Hills to accept the donated funding and to execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to purchase orders and payment requests, which may be necessary for acquisition of this equipment.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the Resolution and shall cause the Resolution and his certification to be entered in the Book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.




