Parking Facility Elevator Status

One elevator at 461 N Bedford is currently out of service. This is an unplanned outage and is pending a major repair and replacement of parts ahead of the scheduled modernization project. This outage has been going on for about one month and will continue for another 8 weeks pending contracting, ordering of parts and actual repair time.

One elevator is out of service at the 440 N. Camden garage as part of the planned Phase 1 modernization project. Once this elevator is placed back into service, the remaining elevator will be taken out of service for modernization. Phase 1 of the modernization project also includes both elevators at the 333 N Crescent Drive/9361 Dayton Way garage. Work is anticipated to begin in late January 2014.

Phase 1 of the modernization project will take approximately 16 weeks total with 6 weeks per elevator.

Parking Services, in conjunction with Project Administration is also working on Phase 2 of the elevator project to completely modernize elevators at 3 additional parking locations to be awarded by Jun 2014 and for work to begin in the 14/15 fiscal year.
