**SUBJECT:** 2015 Traffic & Parking Commission Work Plan Priorities – Summary

---

Traffic & Parking Commission (TPC) developed FY2015-2016 work plan priorities at its November 2014 meeting for City Council consideration at the December 9, 2014 study session. The following list includes traffic and parking-related projects, in no particular order, for consideration:

- Disabled Placards – address placard misuse and enforcement, and continue seeking legislation to develop stringent medical industry standards for issuing disabled placards.
- Preferential Permit Parking Zones – consolidate residential blocks or quadrants with uniform permit regulations to facilitate parking enforcement.
- Taxi Franchise (operations) – continue active enforcement of taxi cabs/companies to ensure compliance with franchise regulations, and monitor Uber and Lyft (shared ride) operations.
- Technology (existing) – improve parking enforcement operations by including applicable regulation information on permit decals (via chip technology).
- Parking Inventory Plan (operations) – identify available occupancy in city and private parking lots to address commercial parking on residential blocks.
- Enhance visibility of crosswalks citywide (operations) – enhance nighttime visibility of crosswalks for motorists and pedestrian safety.
