**A: Projects**

- 1: Citywide re-striping project **-completed**
- 2: Olympic and Beverly-Beverwil intersection- **Pending the review of Traffic & Parking Commission**
- 3: Addition of delineators at (3) intersections of Sunset with Camden, Bedford and Roxbury: Estimated date of delivery and installation is about 10/22/2015. **Completed**

**B: Ongoing traffic studies and data collection (citywide)**

- 1: Conducted multiple day parking inventory surveys for **4** parking prohibition issues and tour bus operation on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.
- 2: Responded to public inquiries about the placement of signs, red curbs, striping, address markings and traffic counts. Responded to requests for information from the public, traffic citation challenges, records subpoenas, expert witness requests, depositions, court appearance requests, complaints about traffic congestion and speeding, school area traffic/parking management inquiries, and other traffic engineering issues (including Web-CBH Transportation public inquiries and citywide Comcate generated public inquiries). **Ongoing- Attended a court hearing and a deposition.**
- 3: Submitted **29** work orders to the Public Works Services Department that included placing or relocating traffic and parking signs, street markings, curb markings, striping plans, and meter heads/posts; signal timing adjustments; and coordination timing and signal pole

C: Private Development Transportation Reviews

1: Continued the review process for Traffic Impact Reports, Environmental Impact Reports and other circulation issues of new developments:

- Review of traffic impact study of the proposed development at 9000 Wilshire Blvd.- **completed**
- Review of traffic circulation issues pertaining to the proposed convenient store addition to the existing 76 station (Olympic and Beverwil) - **completed**
- Review of traffic circulation issues for the proposed development at 325 N. Maple Dr. (former Post Office building) - **continued**
- **Review of traffic circulation of the proposed development at 9212 Olympic**
- **Review of new revisions of 9900 Wilshire project-traffic study and circulation plans**

2: **Reviewed over 62 traffic plan applications** for public right-of-way permits in cooperation with the City's Permit Center. Traffic plans are required to be prepared by applicants for temporary closure of traffic lane(s), generally for the following purposes:

- Delivery of construction equipment and materials; temporary use of metered spaces for special events; and utility repairs/replacements by *Edison*, phone companies and other utility companies.
- *AT&T* projects (reviewed **21** locations)
- *Southern California Edison* construction sites citywide. Completed
- *Metro* La Cienega subway station utilities relocation- water, sewer, *SCE* and storm drain- biweekly coordination meeting with the Metro and LADOT- **attended 2 meetings**
- ***Metro* La Cienega subway station- construction detour alternatives traffic study- coordination with Metro and LADOT- attended 3 meetings**
- Metro Purple Line geotechnical studies: Beverly Hills segment two- reviewed 6 more traffic plans

3: **Reviewed construction-related transportation issues for projects presently under construction:**

- Construction of new hotel (*Waldorf Astoria*) continued. Other improvements include sidewalk setbacks on both Wilshire Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd.; streetwidening; signal improvements at Wilshire Blvd./N. Santa Monica Blvd., Merv Griffin Way/Santa Monica Blvd., and Whittier Dr./Wilshire Blvd. **Began working with the signal design consultant recruited by the applicant to re-design the intersection of Wilshire Blvd. and N. Santa Monica Blvd.**

- 1- Continue working with Metro and LADOT regarding the La Cienega Station construction and the Rodeo Station preliminary geotech investigations
- 2- Continue working With the contractor of Waldorf Astoria regarding improvements of Wilshire Blvd./Santa Monica Blvd., Santa Monica Blvd./Merv Griffin Way and Whittier Dr./Wilshire Blvd.
- 3- Assist in the development of the design process for improvements of N. Santa Monica and construction mitigation
- 4- Conduct a traffic study on the intersection of Rexford Dr. and Beverly Dr. and present findings to the Traffic & Parking Commission
- 5- Conduct a traffic study on the intersection of Hartford Way/Roxbury Dr./Benedict Canyon Dr. and present findings to the Traffic & Parking Commission
- 6- Review the design by the consultant of the signalization of S. Maple Dr. and Wilshire Blvd. as a Lexus development mitigation
- 7- Recruit a design consultant for construction of a new traffic signal at Canon Dr./Clifton Way, mid-block crosswalk signal on Wilshire Blvd. between Palm Dr. and Maple Dr., and mid-block crosswalk signal on the intersection of Chalmers Dr./Roberston Blvd.
- 8- Present a case and recommendations to consolidate the mid-block crosswalk at Lasky Dr. and S. Santa Monica Blvd. with the crosswalk at Wilshire Blvd. and S. Santa Monica Blvd.
- 9- Complete E-filing process of Transportation Division geographical files
- 10- Work with the design consultant on the implementation of Olympic Blvd./Beverly Dr./Bevewil Dr. improvements
- 11- Catch up with on-going studies and day-to-day tasks
