The purpose of this staff report is to provide the Commission with updates on pending items; therefore, the Commission cannot make formal recommendations on these items.

**a. Tour Bus Activity**

The 10,000-pound (5-ton) gross vehicle weight limit within the business triangle went into effect on December 18, 2015, and weight limit signs were installed at street entrances on January 7, 2016. The Beverly Hills Police Department has issued a total of 29 citations related to commercial enforcement activity in the business district for a covering 42 types of violations, including:

BHMC 4-2-706: Identification Card Required: 2  
BHMC 7-2-201a: Heavy Hauling: 1  
BHMC 7-2-207c: Tour Bus unloading in undesignated zone: 2  
BHMC 7-2-208d: Tour Bus staging outside designated area: 4  
Other VC Commercial violations: 11  
Other VC Hazard violations: 3  
Other VC Correctable violations: 19

In addition to Police enforcement, the Parking Enforcement team has issued a total of 53 citations for tour bus violations (BHMC 7-2-207) between January 2015 and January 2016. The majority of the citations (31/53) were issued during the summer peak tour bus activity.

The City's Block-by-Block Ambassadors continue to monitor the 200 North Beverly Drive tour bus passenger loading zone and direct tour vehicles to the Third Street staging area and assist pedestrians/tourists. The Ambassadors assigned to the Beverly Drive tour bus zone counted 127 tour bus vehicles in December and January, and provided an average of 1,400 hospitality assists each month.

**b. Olympic/Beverly/Beverwil Intersection**

Staff will provide City Council an update on mitigation options at the March 1, 2016 study session. The staff report will be available online the weekend of February 27th.

**c. Valet Services**

Staff will provide a report on valet services and operations at the April 7, 2016 Traffic & Parking Commission meeting.
